



NOVENA: A novena is a nine day period of private or public prayer to obtain special graces, to implore (beg) for special favors, or to make special petitions (requests). A novena is a holy, spiritual exercise to strengthen the faith of the person. The individual should truly mean what they are praying for, always remembering the goodness of the Lord who answers all of our prayers according to His divine will.



ADORATION

ADORATION is time spent in prayer before our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament in a chapel or church. The Blessed Sacrament (a host which has been previously *consecrated*—changed into the Body and Blood of Christ, during a Mass) is placed into a beautiful *Monstrance* (a golden receptacle for sacred bread – see below left), and placed upon the altar for all to adore.

<u>BENEDICTION</u>: Adoration, usually ends with Benediction, during which, the priest usually offers incense and prayers - and then gives the benediction (blessing).

To give the Blessing of Jesus, the priest first puts upon his shoulders, the humeral veil (a silk shawl covering the shoulders and hands, worn by a Roman Catholic priest while holding sacred vessels). He then goes to the altar, genuflects, and kneels. When he stands, the Priest lifts the monstrance and uses it to make the sign of the Cross, he is performing "benediction", or giving a blessing. You will notice that the Priest will have his hands covered by the humeral veil he as moves the monstrance. This signifies that it is not the Priest who is giving the blessing, but Jesus Christ Himself, who is exposed and present in the Holy Eucharist.
