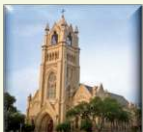

Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

Happy New Year! On last year's feast day of the Immaculate Conception – December 8th – which also turned out to be the 150th anniversary of the proclamation of St. Joseph as the Patron of the Universal Church, Pope Francis proclaimed a **Year of St. Joseph**. The **Year of St. Joseph**, which is from December 8, 2020 to December 8, 2021 is an invitation to all the faithful “to increase our love for this great saint, to encourage us to implore his intercession and to imitate his virtues and his zeal”.

In this New Year, the Holy Father is encouraging us in a special way to look to St. Joseph about whom he shares a beautiful reflection in his Apostolic Letter, *Patris Corde* (“A Father's Heart”). A simple Google search will provide a free copy of this Apostolic Letter and I would like to encourage you to read and reflect upon it.

I was particularly inspired by the Holy Father's description of St. Joseph as a father with **creative courage**. Such a courage, according to the Pontiff, “emerges especially in the way we deal with difficulties. In the face of difficulty, we can either give up and walk away, or somehow engage with it. At times, difficulties bring out resources we did not even think we had”. This courage is evident in the faith we see in the friends of the paralytic who, to get him to Jesus, opened a roof to let him down (cf. Luke 5:17-26). St. Joseph undoubtedly displayed this kind of courage when he took Mary and the child Jesus to Egypt to escape persecution. One can only imagine this courage at play while they lived as sojourners in Egypt.

This creative courage becomes more relevant for us as believers especially as we continue to deal with the ravaging effects of the pandemic that has stubbornly hung around. The Pope reminds us that “God always finds a way to save us, provided we show the same creative courage as the carpenter of Nazareth, who was able to turn a problem into a possibility by trusting always in divine providence”.

During this **Year of St. Joseph**, we will have the opportunity to receive **Plenary Indulgences**. In my next weekly letter, I will share more about the conditions for participating and receiving these indulgences. We will also be sharing resources on our parish website to help promote devotion to St. Joseph as well as to reflect upon his saintly life.

St. Joseph, Patron of the Universal Church, Protector of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph – pray for our families, Amen!

We are one Holy Family Parish, united in the joy of the Holy Spirit and in charity, as missionary disciples, amen!

Mensaje del Pastor

Queridos amados en Cristo:

¡Feliz año nuevo! En la fiesta de la Inmaculada Concepción del año pasado, el 8 de diciembre, que también resultó ser el 150 aniversario de la proclamación de San José como Patrón de la Iglesia Universal, el Papa Francisco proclamó el Año de San José. El Año de San José, que va del 8 de diciembre de 2020 al 8 de diciembre de 2021, es una invitación a todos los fieles a “aumentar nuestro amor por este gran santo, animarnos a implorar su intercesión e imitar sus virtudes y su celo”.

En este Año Nuevo, el Santo Padre nos anima de manera especial a mirar a San José, de quien comparte una hermosa reflexión en su Carta Apostólica *Patris Corde* (“El corazón de un padre”). Una simple búsqueda en Google proporcionará una copia gratuita de esta Carta Apostólica y me gustaría animarle a leerla y reflexionar sobre ella.

Me inspiró particularmente la descripción del Santo Padre de San José como un padre con coraje creativo. Tal valor, según el Pontífice, “surge especialmente en la forma en que afrontamos las dificultades. Ante la dificultad, podemos darnos por vencidos y alejarnos, o de alguna manera comprometernos con ella. A veces, las dificultades sacan a relucir recursos que ni pensábamos tener”. Este valor es evidente en la fe que vemos en los amigos del paralítico que, para llevarlo a Jesús, le abrieron un techo para defraudarlo (cf. Lc 5, 17-26). San José, sin duda, mostró este tipo de coraje cuando llevó a María y al niño Jesús a Egipto para escapar de la persecución. Uno solo puede imaginar este coraje en juego mientras vivían como peregrinos en Egipto.

Este coraje creativo se vuelve más relevante para nosotros como creyentes, especialmente a medida que continuamos lidiando con los devastadores efectos de la pandemia que obstinadamente ha estado rondando. El Papa nos recuerda que “Dios siempre encuentra la manera de salvarnos, siempre que demos el mismo valor creativo que el carpintero de Nazaret, que supo convertir un problema en posibilidad confiando siempre en la divina providencia”.

Durante este Año de San José, tendremos la oportunidad de recibir Indulgencias Plenarias. En mi próxima carta semanal, compartiré más sobre las condiciones para participar y recibir estas indulgencias. También compartiremos recursos en el sitio web de nuestra parroquia para ayudar a promover la devoción a San José, así como para reflexionar sobre su vida santa.

San José, Patrón de la Iglesia Universal, Protector de la Sagrada Familia de Jesús, María y José - ¡Ora por nuestras familias, Amén!

Somos una parroquia de la Sagrada Familia, unidos en la alegría del Espíritu Santo y en la caridad, como discípulos misioneros, ¡amén!

C. **Strengthen your intention** using clear positive statements (present tense). Write it, speak it, and hear it, to make it become a reality. D. **List "to do's" to accomplish your intention:** a. Call church 409-762-9646, give your info so RCIA Director can contact you. E. Come to RCIA Class **every Tues, 7 til 8:30 p.m, in the "Parish Life Center"** across the parking lot from St. Patrick Church on 34th between J & K. Come in through the double doors, in the center of the building. Cheerfully wear your mask.

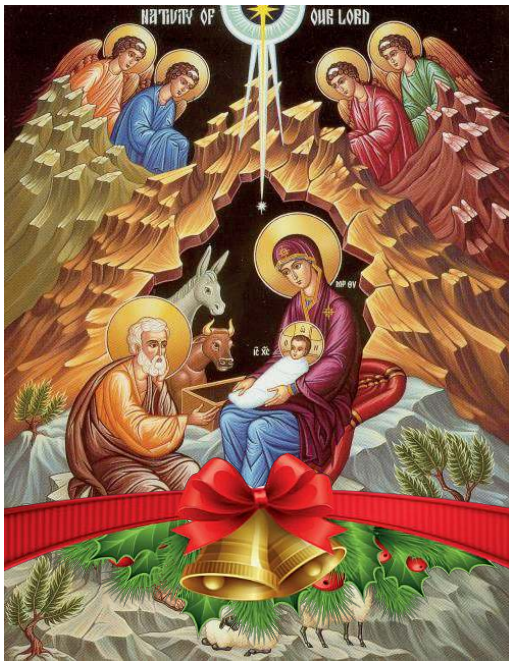

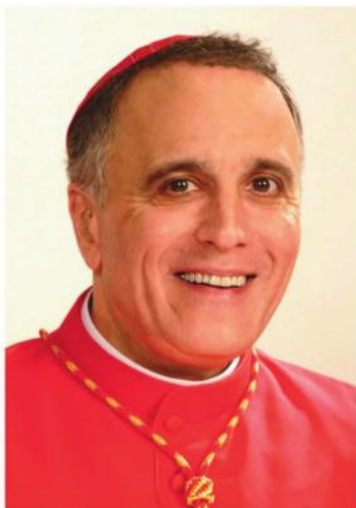
