Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

As we journey through 2021, may we keep the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph always close at heart, especially through our imitation of their obedience to God. God shows his everlasting love for human life in the mystery of the incarnation. Christ, by becoming man, assumed our nature so as to redeem us and to create for us the path to everlasting life.

The Nativity story shows Joseph and Mary as God's loving agents who reverently receive the gift of life and in turn nurture it. In his Apostolic Letter, *Patris Corde*, Pope Francis reminds us that "God trusted Joseph, as did Mary, who found in him someone who would not only save her life, but would always provide for her and her child. In this sense, Saint Joseph could not be other than the Guardian of the Church, for the Church is the continuation of the Body of Christ in history" (#5).

As children of God, we are called to imitate the courage of St. Joseph and of the Blessed Virgin Mary to protect and promote human life from natural conception to natural death. In our nation, we continue to battle with the horrors of legalized abortion, a scourge that continues to eat at the soul of our society. As heinous as abortion is, we must not forget other forms of inhumanities against the human life (such as social injustice and inequality, violence, war, genocide, human trafficking, capital punishment, to mention a few).

Our God is Pro Life because God is the Source of all life. God desires that as His children, we should embrace, celebrate, nurture and safeguard the gift of human life at every stage of its natural course. Here are some recommendations on how we can participate in the good endeavor of promoting the sanctity of human life - a. January 22nd is the Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children. We are invited to participate in the 9 Days For Life Novena (go to: www.usccb.org and in the search bar, type "9 Days For Life"; also, check page 9 of this bulletin); b. If you or someone you know is struggling with the sin of abortion, encourage them to seek the mercy and healing graces of God through the sacrament of reconciliation and/or by speaking with a priest for guidance; c. Educate yourself about issues that adversely affect human life and choose to spread the gospel of life through example, one step at a time.

May we continue to grow in the grace of Divine life and seek to promote it everywhere, every day! We are one Holy Family Parish, united in the joy of the Holy Spirit and in charity, as missionary disciples, amen!



RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS

THE SIGN OF THE CROSS IN

RCIA...is the first Catholic prayer we learn. Many long time Catholics may have forgotten exactly what it is and why we say it, but check this out and you may be surprised at what you can also learn.

Not all prayers are made with words. Prayers may also be made by gestures. The sign of the cross is a beautiful gesture which reminds the faithful of the cross of salvation while calling upon the Holy Trinity (Father, Son, and Holy Spirit). Technically, the sign of the cross is a sacramental, a sacred sign begun by the Church. When we say it, it prepares us to receive grace and to make holy a moment or circumstance.

When we make the Sign of the Cross, it should be made consciously and devoutly. Whenever we are in church, even walking up or down the aisle, we should have our hands folded reverently. With your left hand over your heart, the sign of the cross is made using the fingertips of your right hand, you should touch your forehead at the mention of the Father; the lower middle of your chest at the mention of the Son; and the left shoulder on the word "Holy" and the right shoulder on the word "Spirit."


In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

JAN 21st | DAY ONE:

May the tragic practice of abortion end.

Reflection: At every stage and in every circumstance, we are held in existence by God's love. The presence of an illness, disability, or other challenging situation never diminishes the value of a human life. God does not call us to perfection of appearance or abilities, but to perfection in *love*. Christ invites us to embrace our own lives and the lives of others as true *gifts*. Abortion tragically rejects the truth that every life is a good and perfect gift, deserving protection. This violent practice ends the life of a human being at its very beginning and horribly wounds all those involved. But Christ came that we "might have life and have it more abundantly" (John 10:10), taking on human flesh for the sake of our redemption. May our culture experience the power of God's transforming love, that all eyes may be opened to the incredible beauty of every human life.

JAN 22ND | DAY TWO:

May all unborn children be protected in law and welcomed in love.


Reflection: Today, on this 48th anniversary of *Roe v. Wade*, we mourn the many children's lives ended by abortion and remember in prayer those who suffer the aftermath. The Church comes together today to pray for the protection of all unborn children and to make reparation for abortion, trusting that the Lord hears our prayers. The importance of prayer is reflected in *Evangelium vitae*, which says, "A great prayer for life is urgently needed, a prayer which will rise up throughout the world. Through special initiatives and in daily prayer, may an impassioned plea rise to God, the Creator and lover of life, from every Christian community, from every group and association, from every family and from the heart of every believer" (*EV* 100). May that prayer arise in our hearts today and each day forward until every human being is protected in law and welcomed in love.

JAN 23RD | DAY THREE:


May every expectant mother receive compassionate care and support as she nurtures the life in her womb.

Reflection: When the angel Gabriel appeared to Mary, she opened her heart to receive his message that she would conceive the Son of God in her womb. As a young, betrothed, but unmarried, woman, Mary knew that her pregnancy presented many challenges. Despite this knowledge, she faithfully responded, "Behold, I am the handmaid of the Lord. May it be done to me according to your word" (Luke 1:38). Like the Blessed Mother, women who unexpectedly become pregnant often face significant challenges. They, too, are called to place their trust in God and faithfully respond to His *gift* of new life. And we are called to walk with them in their time of need. As Jesus taught us, when we love and serve others, we are loving and serving Him. May all expectant mothers be encouraged by Mary's example and receive support and grace in lovingly welcoming their children into the world.


Prayer to St. Joseph






