Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

This weekend, parishes throughout the archdiocese will begin introducing the annual **Diocesan Services Fund (DSF)** campaign. The theme of this year's DSF campaign is: **Walk in the Light of Christ**. We all can attest to the gripping darkness that has enshrouded the world lately, especially in light of the ongoing pandemic. In moments of darkness, the temptation to give in to despair or other forms of hopelessness becomes prevalent. Christ, the light of the world, never abandons us. It is only in his light, that we find our way.

The global pandemic not only taught us how vulnerable we all are but also showed the beauty of how working together can help to accomplish even greater things. Through the Diocesan Services Fund, our archdiocese is able to provide needed support for over 60 different ministries that cover areas such as faith formation; social assistance through agencies/offices like Catholic Charities and Correctional Ministries for those incarcerated; young adult and campus ministries; and formation to the priesthood and the diaconate. The DSF is a way for the parishes that make up our beautiful archdiocese to come together to support the ministries of the archdiocese and together accomplish far greater works than any individual parish could.

Our parish has been very generous to the DSF campaign and as your pastor, I am very grateful for your faithful participation. Our parish DSF goal for this year is \$83,000.00, which is \$2,000.00 more than last year's. This year marks the start of the unfreezing of the DSF goals for all parishes, which were frozen at the start of the Ignite Campaign in 2017. By 2023, the DSF goals for parishes will be based on the 10 % average of the last 3 years' collection (i.e. of 2020, 2021 and 2022). The increment will happen gradually, though. Thus, this year's goal reflects an increase of no more than 3% of last year's (i.e. 2020's) annual collection; 2022 will see an increase of no more than 5% of 2021's annual total collection. It is important to note that most parishes are not assessed the true amount of the above calculation formula. Rather, each parish's goal is set with considerations of their offertory fluctuations and other societal events that have an impact on families.

This weekend, we will all review this year's DSF campaign video and other related materials in preparation for the first **DSF Commitment** (that will take place next weekend), when we make our pledges. Thank you for your support in bringing the *light* **of Christ** through the DSF to our brothers and sisters everywhere.

We are one Holy Family Parish, united in the joy of the Holy Spirit and in charity, as missionary disciples, amen!

Mensaje del Pastor

Queridos amados en Cristo:

Este fin de semana, las parroquias de la arquidiócesis comenzarán a presentar la campaña anual **Diocesan Services Fund** (**DSF**). El tema de la campaña DSF de este año es: **Camine en la luz de Cristo**. Todos podemos dar fe de la sobrecogedora oscuridad que ha envuelto al mundo últimamente, especialmente a la luz de la pandemia en curso. En momentos de oscuridad, prevalece la tentación de ceder a la desesperación u otras formas de desesperanza. Cristo, la luz del mundo, nunca nos abandona. Es solo en su luz que encontramos nuestro camino.

La pandemia mundial no solo nos enseñó lo vulnerables que somos todos, sino que también mostró la belleza de cómo trabajar juntos puede ayudar a lograr cosas aún mayores. A través del Fondo de Servicios Diocesanos, nuestra arquidiócesis puede brindar el apoyo necesario para más de 60 ministerios diferentes que cubren áreas como la formación en la fe; asistencia social a través de agencias / oficinas como Caridades Católicas y Ministerios Correccionales para los encarcelados; ministerios universitarios y de jóvenes adultos; y formación al sacerdocio y al diaconado. El DSF es una forma para que las parroquias que componen nuestra hermosa arquidiócesis se unan para apoyar los ministerios de la arquidiócesis y juntos lograr trabajos mucho más grandes que cualquier parroquia individual.

Nuestra parroquia ha sido muy generosa con la campaña de DSF y como su párroco, estoy muy agradecido por su fiel participación. Nuestra meta parroquial de DSF para este año es \$83,000.00, que es \$2,000.00 más que el año pasado. Este año marca el inicio de la descongelación de los objetivos del DSF para todas las parroquias, que se congelaron al inicio de la Campaña Ignite en 2017. Para el 2023, los objetivos del DSF para las parroquias se basarán en el promedio del 10% de los últimos 3 años. 'colección (es decir, de 2020, 2021 y 2022). Sin embargo, el incremento ocurrirá gradualmente. Por lo tanto, la meta de este año refleja un aumento de no más del 3% de la recaudación anual del año pasado (es decir, 2020); 2022 verá un aumento de no más del 5% de la recaudación total anual de 2021. Es importante notar que a la mayoría de las parroquias no se les evalúa la cantidad real de la fórmula de cálculo anterior. Más bien, el objetivo de cada parroquia se establece teniendo en cuenta las fluctuaciones de su ofertorio y otros eventos sociales que tienen un impacto en las familias.

Este fin de semana, todos revisaremos el video de la campaña DSF de este año y otros materiales relacionados en preparación para el primer **Compromiso DSF** (que tendrá lugar el próximo fin de semana), cuando hagamos nuestras promesas. Gracias por su apoyo para traer la **luz de Cristo** a través del DSF a nuestros hermanos y hermanas en todas partes.

Somos una parroquia de la Sagrada Familia, unidos en la alegría del Espíritu Santo y en la caridad, como discípulos misioneros, jamén!

School News






FEBRUARY 27, 2021 at 10:00 AM
