Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

It is hard to believe, but **Lent** is already upon us! This **Wednesday**, **Feb. 17**, we begin our annual Lenten spiritual pilgrimage for the Easter Season, in imitation of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ who spent forty days and nights in prayer and fasting. Please see the bulletin for **Ash Wednesday** celebrations.

Many have reached out to inquire if there will be distribution of ashes this year, given the ongoing pandemic. The answer is "yes", but with some modifications. On January 12, 2021, the Congregation for Divine Worship and the Discipline of the Sacraments in Rome, gave a directive for the blessing/distribution of ashes. The celebrant blesses the ashes in the usual way as set forth in the Roman Missal, after which he addresses those present briefly and then says the following formula over all those present ONLY once: "Repent, and believe in the Gospel", or "Remember that you are dust, and to dust you shall return". With his mask on, the celebrant then distribute ashes to the faithful by sprinkling a pinch of it on the crown of each individual's head without saying a word.

Also, for this year ONLY, on the **feast of St. Blaise** (Wednesday, Feb. 3), the traditional blessing of throats was done differently. Rather than bless the throat of each individual with two candles, the priest blessed the throats of all present at Mass on that day by extending his hands over everyone, while he recited the prayer of blessings. It is important to note that the **Book of Blessings**, used by the clergy for imparting blessings on the faithful, has this accommodation within it and prescribes it for pastoral reasons as is the case with the current times.

Stations of the Cross will be on Fridays at St. Patrick's Church at 5:30 PM (in English) and 7:00 PM (in Spanish). Our Lady of Guadalupe chapel will continue to remain open during office hours on weekdays for private prayers. For individuals who may desire to pray the Stations of the Cross privately, this can also be done in the chapel or at St. Patrick's Church on Wednesdays, during the hours of Eucharistic exposition. Please be mindful of your brothers and sisters who may also be present in the chapel/church when you come to visit with the Lord and spend some time with him in prayer.

We are one Holy Family Parish, united in the joy of the Holy Spirit and in charity, as missionary disciples, amen!

Mensaje del Pastor

Queridos amados en Cristo:

Es difícil de creer, ¡pero la Cuaresma ya está sobre nosotros! Este miércoles 17 de febrero comenzamos nuestra peregrinación espiritual anual de Cuaresma para la temporada de Pascua, a imitación de nuestro Señor y Salvador Jesucristo, quien pasó cuarenta días y noches en oración y ayuno. Consulte el boletín para las celebraciones del Miércoles de Ceniza.

Muchos se han acercado para preguntar si habrá distribución de cenizas este año, dada la pandemia en curso. La respuesta es "sí", pero con algunas modificaciones. El 12 de enero de 2021, la Congregación para el Culto Divino y la Disciplina de los Sacramentos en Roma, dio una directiva para la bendición / distribución de cenizas. El celebrante bendice las cenizas de la manera habitual como se establece en el Misal Romano, después de lo cual se dirige a los presentes brevemente y luego dice la siguiente fórmula sobre todos los presentes SÓLO una vez: "Arrepentíos y creed en el Evangelio", o "Recuerda que eres polvo, y al polvo volverás ". Con su máscara puesta, el celebrante luego distribuye cenizas a los fieles rociando una pizca de ella en la coronilla de la cabeza de cada individuo sin decir una palabra.

Además, SOLAMENTE para este año, en la **fiesta de San Blas** (miércoles 3 de febrero), la tradicional bendición de gargantas se hizo de manera diferente. En lugar de bendecir la garganta de cada individuo con dos velas, el sacerdote bendijo las gargantas de todos los presentes en la Misa de ese día extendiendo sus manos sobre todos, mientras recitaba la oración de bendición. Es importante señalar que el **Libro de Bendiciones**, utilizado por el clero para impartir bendiciones a los fieles, tiene esta acomodación dentro y lo prescribe por razones pastorales como es el caso de los tiempos actuales.

El Vía Crucis será los viernes en la Iglesia de San Patricio a las 5:30 p.m. (en inglés) y a las 7:00 p.m. (en español). La capilla de Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe seguirá abierta durante el horario de oficina los días de semana para oraciones privadas. Para las personas que deseen rezar el Vía Crucis en privado, esto también se puede hacer en la capilla o en la Iglesia de San Patricio los miércoles, durante las horas de exposición eucarística. Tenga en cuenta a sus hermanos y hermanas que también pueden estar presentes en la capilla / iglesia cuando venga a visitar al Señor y pase algún tiempo con él en oración.

Somos una parroquia de la Sagrada Familia, unidos en la alegría del Espíritu Santo y en la caridad, como discípulos misioneros, ¡amén!




