Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

I pray that you are still persevering in the Lenten observances. During Lent, we are called to do more intensely – i.e., pray, fast and give alms – what we should always do, in order for us to continue abiding in the path of salvation. Christ is the way to eternal life and St. Augustine's reflection below – which is part of our ongoing *Conversations with the Saints* series – is a powerful reminder of this truth.

"The Lord tells us: I am the light of the world; he who follows me will not walk in darkness, but will have the light of life. In these few words he gives a command and makes a promise. Let us do what he commands so that we may not blush to covet what he promises and to hear him say on the day of judgment: "I laid down certain conditions for obtaining my promises. Have you fulfilled them?" If you say: "What did you command, Lord our God?" he will tell you: "I commanded you to follow me. You asked for advice on how to enter into life. What life, if not the life about which it is written: With you is the fountain of life?"

Let us do now what he commands. Let us follow in the footsteps of the Lord. Let us throw off the chains that prevent us from following him. Who can throw off these shackles without the aid of the one addressed in these words: You have broken my chains? Another psalm says of him: The Lord frees those in chains, the Lord raises up the downcast.

Those who have been freed and raised up follow the light. The light they follow speaks to them: *I am the light of the world; he who follows me will not walk in darkness.* The Lord gives light to the blind. Brethren, that light shines on us now, for we have had our eyes anointed with the eye-salve of faith. His saliva was mixed with earth to anoint the man born blind. We are of Adam's stock, blind from our birth; we need him to give us light. He mixed saliva with earth, and so it was prophesied: *Truth has sprung up from the earth.* He himself has said: *I am the way, the truth, and the life.*

We shall be in possession of the truth when we see face to face. This is his promise to us. Who would dare to hope for something that God in his goodness did not choose to promise or bestow?

We shall see face to face. The Apostle says: Now I know in part, now obscurely through a mirror, but then face to face. John the apostle says in one of his letters: Dearly beloved, we are now children of God, and it has not yet been revealed what we shall be. We know that when he is revealed we shall be like him, for we shall see him as he is. This is a great promise.

If you love me, follow me. "I do love you," you protest, "but how do I follow you?" If the Lord your God said to you: "I am the truth and the life," in your desire for truth, in your love for life, you would certainly ask him to show you the way to reach them. You would say to yourself: "Truth is a great reality, life is a great reality; if only it were possible for my soul to find them!"

We are one Holy Family Parish, united in the joy of the Holy Spirit and in charity, as missionary disciples, amen!

Mensaje del Pastor

Queridos amados en Cristo:

Oro para que sigan perseverando en las observancias de la Cuaresma. Durante la Cuaresma, estamos llamados a hacer más intensamente, es decir, orar, ayunar y dar limosna, lo que siempre debemos hacer, para que podamos seguir viviendo en el camino de la salvación. Cristo es el camino a la vida eterna y la reflexión de San Agustín a continuación, que es parte de nuestra serie de Conversaciones con los Santos en curso, es un poderoso recordatorio de esta verdad.

"El Señor dijo concisamente: Yo soy la luz del mundo: el que me sigue no camina en tinieblas, sino que tendrá la luz de la vida. Con estas palabras nos mandó una cosa y nos prometió otra. Hagamos lo que nos mandó y, de esta forma, no desearemos de manera insolente lo que nos prometió; no sea que tenga que decirnos el día del juicio: «¿Hiciste lo que mandé, para poder pedirme ahora lo que prometí?» «¿Qué es lo que mandaste, Señor, Dios nuestro?» Te dice: «Que me siguieras.» Pediste un consejo de vida. ¿De qué vida sino de aquella de la que se dijo: En ti está la fuente de la vida?

Conque hagámoslo ahora, sigamos al Señor; desatemos aquellas ataduras que nos impiden seguirlo. Pero ¿quién será capaz de desatar tales nudos, si no nos ayuda aquel mismo a quien se dijo: Rompiste mis cadenas? El mismo de quien en otro salmo se afirma: El Señor liberta a los cautivos, el Señor endereza a los que ya se doblan.

¿Y en pos de qué corren los liberados y los puestos en pie, sino de la luz de la que han oído: Yo soy la luz del mundo: el que me sigue no camina en tinieblas? Porque el Señor abre los ojos al ciego. Quedaremos iluminados, hermanos, si tenemos el colirio de la fe. Porque fue necesaria la saliva de Cristo mezclada con tierra para ungir al ciego de nacimiento. También nosotros hemos nacido ciegos por causa de Adán, y necesitamos que el Señor nos ilumine. Mezcló saliva con tierra; por ello está escrito: La Palabra se hizo carne y acampó entre nosotros. Mezcló saliva con tierra, pues estaba también anunciado: La verdad brota de la tierra; y él mismo había dicho: Yo soy el camino, y la verdad, y la vida.

Disfrutaremos de la verdad cuando lleguemos a verlo cara a cara, pues también esto se nos promete. Porque, ¿quién se atrevería a esperar lo que Dios no se hubiese dignado dar o prometer?

Lo veremos cara a cara. El Apóstol dice: Ahora vemos confusamente en un espejo; entonces veremos cara a cara. Y Juan añade en su carta: Queridos, ahora somos hijos de Dios y aún no se ha manifestado lo que seremos. Sabemos que, cuando se manifieste, seremos semejantes a él, porque lo veremos tal cual es. Ésta es una gran promesa.

Si lo amas, síguelo. «Yo lo amo —me dices—, pero ¿por qué camino lo sigo?» Si el Señor, tu Dios, te hubiese dicho: «Yo soy la verdad y la vida», y tú deseases la verdad y anhelaras la vida, sin duda que hubieras preguntado por el camino para alcanzarlas, y te estarías diciendo: «Gran cosa es la verdad, gran cosa es la vida; ojalá mi alma tuviera la posibilidad de llegar hasta ellas.»

Somos una parroquia de la Sagrada Familia, unidos en el gozo del Espíritu Santo y en la caridad, como discípulos misioneros, jamén!


THANKS FOR COMING BACK! MORE GREAT INFO ABOUT OUR SACRED EUCHARIST:

In RCIA, they are discussing the information on the Holy Eucharist in which the Catholic Church professes that, in the celebration of the Eucharist, bread and wine become the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ through the power of the Holy Spirit and the instrumentality of the priest. Jesus said:

"I am the living bread that came down from heaven; whoever eats this bread will live forever; and the bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world. . . For my flesh is true food, and my blood is true drink" (Jn 6:51-55).

The whole CHRIST is truly present, body, blood, soul, and divinity, under the appearances of bread and wine—the glorified Christ who rose from the dead after dying for our sins. 
