Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

Our Lenten *Conversations with the Saints* series continues, on this **Palm Sunday of the Lord's Passion**, with the following reflection from the Bishop, Saint Andrew of Crete:

"Let us go together to meet Christ on the Mount of Olives. Today he returns from Bethany and proceeds of his own free will toward his holy and blessed passion, to consummate the mystery of our salvation. He who came down from heaven to raise us from the depths of sin, to raise us with himself, we are told in Scripture, above every sovereignty, authority, and power, and every other name that can be named, now comes of his own free will to make his journey to Jerusalem. He comes without pomp or ostentation. As the psalmist says: He will not dispute or raise his voice to make it heard in the streets. He will be meek and humble, and he will make his entry in simplicity.

Let us run to accompany him as he hastens toward Jerusalem, and imitate those who met him then, not by covering his path with garments, olive branches or palms, but by doing all we can to prostrate ourselves before him by being humble and by trying to live as he would wish. Then we shall be able to receive the Word at his coming, and God, whom no limits can contain, will be within us.

In his humility Christ entered the dark regions of our fallen world and he is glad that he became so humble for our sake, glad that he came and lived among us and shared in our nature in order to raise us up again to himself. And even though we are told that he has now ascended above the highest heavens—the proof, surely, of his power and godhead—his love for man will never rest until he has raised our earthbound nature from glory to glory, and made it one with his own in heaven.

So let us spread before his feet, not garments or soulless olive branches, which delight the eye for a few hours and then wither, but ourselves, clothed in his grace, or rather, clothed completely in him. We who have been baptized into Christ must ourselves be the garments that we spread before him. Now that the crimson stains of our sins have been washed away in the saving waters of baptism and we have become white as pure wool, let us present the conqueror of death, not with mere branches of palms but with the real rewards of his victory. Let our souls take the place of the welcoming branches as we join today in the children's holy song: Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord. Blessed is the king of Israel."

Let us be *passionate* for God; Let us surrender to His will always! We are **one Holy Family Parish**, **united in the joy of the Holy Spirit and in charity**, **as missionary disciples**, **amen!**

Queridos amados en Cristo:

Nuestra serie *Conversaciones de Cuaresma con los Santos* continúa, en este **Domingo de Ramos** de la Pasión del Señor, con la siguiente reflexión del Obispo San Andrés de Creta:

"Venid, y al mismo tiempo que ascendemos al monte de los Olivos, salgamos al encuentro de Cristo, que vuelve hoy de Betania y, por propia voluntad, se apresura hacia su venerable y dichosa pasión, para llevar a plenitud el misterio de la salvación de los hombres. Porque el que va libremente hacia Jerusalén es el mismo que por nosotros, los hombres, bajó del cielo, para levantar consigo a los que yacíamos en lo más profundo y colocarnos, como dice la Escritura, por encima de todo principado, potestad, fuerza y dominación, y por encima de todo nombre conocido. Y viene, no como quien busca su gloria por medio de la fastuosidad y de la pompa. No porfiará —dice—, no gritará, no voceará por las calles, sino que será manso y humilde, y se presentará sin espectacularidad alguna.

Ea, pues, corramos a una con quien se apresura a su pasión, e imitemos a quienes salieron a su encuentro. Y no para extender por el suelo, a su paso, ramos de olivo, vestiduras o palmas, sino para prosternarnos nosotros mismos, con la disposición más humillada de que seamos capaces y con el más limpio propósito, de manera que acojamos al Verbo que viene, y así logremos captar a aquel Dios que nunca puede ser totalmente captado por nosotros.

Alegrémonos, pues, porque se nos ha presentado mansamente el que es manso y que asciende sobre el ocaso de nuestra ínfima vileza, para venir hasta nosotros y convivir con nosotros, de modo que pueda, por su parte, llevarnos hasta la familiaridad con él. Ya que, si bien se dice que, habiéndose incorporado las primicias de nuestra condición, ascendió, conese botín, sobre los cielos, hacia el oriente, es decir, según me parece, hacia su propia gloria y divinidad, no abandonó, con todo, su propensión hacia el género humano hasta haber sublimado al hombre, elevándolo progresivamente desde lo más ínfimo de la tierra hasta lo más alto de los cielos. Así es como nosotros deberíamos prosternarnos a los pies de Cristo, no poniendo bajo sus pies nuestras túnicas o unas ramas inertes, que muy pronto perderían verdor, su fruto y su aspecto agradable, sino revistiéndonos de su gracia, es decir, de él mismo, pues los que os habéis incorporado a Cristo por el bautismo os habéis revestido de Cristo.

Así debemos ponernos a sus pies como si fuéramos unas túnicas. Y sí antes, teñidos como estábamos de la escarlata del pecado, volvimos a encontrar la blancura de la lana gracias al saludable baño del bautismo, ofrezcamos ahora al vencedor de la muerte no ya ramas de palma, sino trofeos de victoria. Repitamos cada día aquella sagrada exclamación que los niños cantaban, mientras agitamos los ramos espirituales del alma: Bendito el que viene, como rey, en nombre del Señor.

Seamos apasionados por Dios; ¡Rindámonos a Su voluntad siempre! Somos una parroquia de la Sagrada Familia, unidos en el gozo del Espíritu Santo y en la caridad, como discípulos misioneros, ¡amén!
