Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ,

The Sunday after Easter is also known as **Sunday of Divine Mercy** [or more commonly, *Divine Mercy Sunday*]. At the heart of the Divine Mercy message is the assurance that God loves us and that His mercy is greater than our sins. We can call to mind this Divine Mercy message by remembering **ABC**:

- **A Ask for mercy**. God invites us to approach him in prayer constantly, asking for mercy for our sins. In today's Gospel, we see Christ investing his apostles with the ministry of forgiving sins. The ordained priest continues this ministry through the **Sacrament of Reconciliation**. When was the last time you went to confession? It is free and good for the soul what are you waiting for?
- **B Be merciful**. As we receive God's mercy, He wants us to become instruments through which His mercy flows to others. In the Beatitude, Christ says to us: *Blessed are the merciful, for they shall have mercy shown to them in return*. Is there someone in need of your forgiveness, kindness or compassion? Remember that kindness shown to another is a pleasing sacrifice to the Lord, which attracts His abundant blessings in return (see: **1 Peter 4:8**; **Proverbs 19:17**).
- C Completely trust in Jesus. The more we trust in God's mercy, the more we are able to receive it. No situation is beyond the reach of God's mercy. All we need to do is trust in God's boundless mercy and reach out to Him, asking for His help. The thief who prayed to Christ for mercy at the hour of his death was met with the compassion and mercy of God (see: Luke 23:39-43). Trust in God and never lose hope, no matter how bleak the situation might seem.

In recent years, we have been able to offer the Divine Mercy Devotion together as a community, following the 12:30 PM Mass. Although that would not be possible this year, I would like to invite us all to offer the Divine Mercy chaplet wherever we may be, asking for God's merciful intervention for an end to the global COVID-19 Pandemic.

Let us also remember to pray for all the sick and for our brothers and sisters who have died during this pandemic; for the healthcare professionals and first responders who are at the frontlines, dealing with the pandemic; and for all public officials, that God may grant them wisdom and the fortitude they need as they carry out their civic responsibilities.

We are one Holy Family Parish, united in the joy of the Holy Spirit and in charity, as missionary disciples, amen!

Mensgje del Pastor

Queridos amados en Cristo:

El domingo después de Pascua también se conoce como **Domingo de la Divina Misericordia.** En el corazón del mensaje de la Divina Misericordia está la seguridad de que Dios nos ama y que Su misericordia es mayor que nuestros pecados. Podemos recordar este mensaje de la Divina Misericordia recordando **ABC**:

- A Pide misericordia. Dios nos invita a acercarnos a él en oración constantemente, pidiendo misericordia por nuestros pecados. En el evangelio de hoy, vemos a Cristo investiendo a sus apóstoles con el ministerio de perdonar pecados. El sacerdote ordenado continúa este ministerio a través del Sacramento de la Reconciliación. ¿Cuándo fue la última vez que se confesó? Es gratis y bueno para el alma, ¿a qué estás esperando?
- **B Sea misericordioso.** Al recibir la misericordia de Dios, Él quiere que seamos instrumentos a través de los cuales Su misericordia fluye hacia los demás. En la Bienaventuranza, Cristo nos dice: *Bienaventurados los misericordiosos, porque ellos recibirán misericordia de ellos*. ¿Hay alguien que necesite tu perdón, bondad o compasión? Recuerde que la bondad mostrada a otro es un sacrificio agradable al Señor, que atrae a cambio Sus abundantes bendiciones (ver: **1 Pedro 4: 8; Proverbios 19:17).**
- C Confiar plenamente en Jesús. Cuanto más confiamos en la misericordia de Dios, más podemos recibirla. Ninguna situación está fuera del alcance de la misericordia de Dios. Todo lo que tenemos que hacer es confiar en la misericordia ilimitada de Dios y acercarnos a Él, pidiendo Su ayuda. El ladrón que oró a Cristo pidiendo misericordia en la hora de su muerte se encontró con la compasión y la misericordia de Dios (ver: Lucas 23: 39-43). Confíe en Dios y nunca pierda la esperanza, no importa cuán desoladora pueda parecer la situación.

En los últimos años, hemos podido ofrecer la Devoción a la Divina Misericordia juntos como comunidad, después de la Misa de las 12:30 PM. Aunque eso no sería posible este año, me gustaría invitarnos a todos a ofrecer la Coronilla de la Divina Misericordia donde sea podemos estar, pidiendo la intervención misericordiosa de Dios para poner fin a la pandemia global de COVID-19.

Recordemos también orar por todos los enfermos y por nuestros hermanos y hermanas que han muerto durante esta pandemia; para los profesionales de la salud y los socorristas que están en primera línea, lidiando con la pandemia; y para todos los funcionarios públicos, para que Dios les conceda la sabiduría y la fortaleza que necesitan en el desempeño de sus responsabilidades cívicas.

Somos una parroquia de la Sagrada Familia, unidos en el gozo del Espíritu Santo y en la caridad, como discípulos misioneros, ¡amén!



A STRONG START IN THE FAITH



The souls who especially venerate and glorify Jesus' mercy


DAY 8 (Easter Friday)

How to pray The Chaplet of Divine Mercy

1. Make the Sign of the Cross

2. (Optional*) Pray,

You expired, Jesus, but the source of life gushed forth for souls, and the ocean of mercy opened up for the whole world. O Fount of Life, unfathomable Divine Mercy, envelop the whole world and empty Yourself out upon us.

O Blood and Water, which gushed forth from the Heart of Jesus as a fountain of Mercy for us, I trust in You!

Our Father,

Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be Thy name; Thy kingdom come; Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us; and lead us not into temptation; but deliver us from evil. Amen.

"Hail Mary,"

Hail Mary, full of grace, the Lord is with thee; blessed art thou among women, and blessed is the fruit of thy womb, Jesus. Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us sinners, now and at the hour of our death. Amen.

"And The Apostle's Creed."

I believe in God, the Father almighty, Creator of heaven and earth, and in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died and was buried: He descended into hell; on the third day He rose again from the dead; He ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of God the Father almighty; from there He will come to judge the living and the dead

_I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Holy Catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting. Amen.

On the Our Father beads

Eternal Father, I offer You the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your dearly beloved Son. Our Lord Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world.

5. On the Hail Mary Beads pray,

For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

6. Pray three times,

Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

(Optional*) Eternal God, in whom mercy is endless and the treasury of compassion inexhaustible, look kindly upon us and increase Your mercy in us, that in difficult moments we might not despair nor become despondent, but with great confidence submit ourselves to Your holy will, which is Love and Mercy itself.

Close with the Sign of the Cross.

Jesus' promise to St. Faustina


