### Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

Today the Church celebrates the **Feast of the Ascension of the Lord!** This feast normally falls on a
Thursday, as the fortieth day following the resurrection of
Christ falls on a Thursday. However, since Canon 1246, §2 of
the **Code of Canon Law** gives the right to a conference of
bishops to "abolish certain days of obligation or **transfer them to a Sunday with prior approval of the Apostolic See**", the National Conference of Catholic Bishops of the
United States in 1999, decided that each Ecclesiastical
province in the United States may transfer the Solemnity of
the Ascension of Our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ from
Thursday of the Sixth Week of Easter to the Seventh Sunday
of Easter. This is why we celebrate this feast on Sunday.

Many older Catholics might be used to celebrating this feast on a Thursday, thus the phrase: "Ascension Thursday". Since it is optional for certain feasts to be transferred to a Sunday in order to provide the opportunity for more of the Faithful to participate in it, the feast of the Ascension could be celebrated on a Thursday or on a Sunday, as I have explained. In many regions of the world, it is still celebrated on a Thursday.

Christ's ascension into heaven vindicates Him as the Son of God who does his Father's will; confirms His message of salvation as altogether reliable; and invites us to be His faithful witnesses to the ends of the earth.

By ascending, Christ did not abandon us; rather, he has gone before us so that where He, the Master and Leader has gone, we too may follow. This truth is expressed beautifully in our opening prayer, thus: "[the] Ascension of Christ is our exaltation, and, where the Head has gone before in glory, the Body is called to follow in hope". May we always keep our eyes on Jesus and on the things of heaven, amen!

Remember that our Holy Family Catholic school is currently enrolling students for the 2021-2022 academic school year. Parents, grandparents and guardians, we are inviting you to partner with us to ensure that your children receive a solid Catholic foundation in their lives.

We are one Holy Family Parish, united in the joy of the Holy Spirit and in charity, as missionary disciples, amen!

#### Mensaje del Pastor

Queridos amados en Cristo:

¡Hoy la Iglesia celebra la Fiesta de la Ascensión del Señor! Esta fiesta normalmente cae en jueves, ya que el cuadragésimo día después de la resurrección de Cristo cae en jueves. Sin embargo, dado que el Canon 1246, §2 del Código de Derecho Canónico otorga el derecho a una conferencia de obispos para "abolir ciertos días de obligación o transferirlos a un domingo con la aprobación previa de la Sede Apostólica", la Conferencia Nacional de Obispos Católicos de los Estados Unidos en 1999, decidió que cada provincia eclesiástica en los Estados Unidos puede transferir la Solemnidad de la Ascensión de Nuestro Señor y Salvador Jesucristo desde el jueves de la Sexta Semana de Pascua al Séptimo Domingo de Pascua. Por eso celebramos esta fiesta el domingo.

Muchos católicos mayores podrían estar acostumbrados a celebrar esta fiesta un jueves, de ahí la frase: "Jueves de la Ascensión". Dado que es opcional que ciertas fiestas se transfieran a un domingo para brindar la oportunidad de que más Fieles participen en ella, la fiesta de la Ascensión podría celebrarse un jueves o un domingo, como he explicado. En muchas regiones del mundo, todavía se celebra los jueves.

La ascensión de Cristo al cielo lo reivindica como el Hijo de Dios que hace la voluntad de su Padre; confirma Su mensaje de salvación como completamente confiable; y nos invita a ser sus fieles testigos hasta los confines de la tierra.

Al ascender, Cristo no nos abandonó; más bien, él ha ido antes que nosotros para que donde Él, el Maestro y Líder haya ido, nosotros también podamos seguirlo. Esta verdad se expresa bellamente en nuestra oración de apertura, así: "[la] Ascensión de Cristo es nuestra exaltación, y, donde la Cabeza ha ido antes en gloria, el Cuerpo está llamado a seguir en esperanza". Que siempre mantengamos nuestros ojos en Jesús y en las cosas del cielo. ¡Amén!

### Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord

Today the Church celebrates the Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord. A common question that may arise is, what actually is a solemnity? A solemnity, which comes from two Latin words meaning "festival" and "annual", is just that, a yearly celebration. Solemnities are the highest feast days in the Church and such joyous occasions! The Solemnity of the Ascension celebrates the day in which Jesus Christ, after the Resurrection, returned to Heaven. In the very end of the Gospel of Mark, we read "So then the Lord Jesus, after he had spoken to them, was taken up into heaven, and sat down at the right hand of God. And they went forth and preached everywhere, while the Lord worked with them and confirmed the message by the signs that attended it. Amen" (Mk 16:19-20). Jesus' departure probably came as a bit of a surprise to the apostles, after all, they had mourned His death, only to see Him again 3 days later when He rose from the dead, and maybe this was a hard goodbye for them. Maybe they felt they needed more time with Him, but Jesus knew that His faithful followers were ready to go out and preach all that He had taught them. Jesus accomplished what He came to the Earth to do and now it was time for Him to place the future of the Church into the hands of those He personally chose to lead it. Were the apostles perfect? Of course not. Would they end up making mistakes? Of course they would. But Christ trusted them with an important mission and now came the time for them to step up to the plate! The Ascension of Jesus also reminds us of His true place in the world, as the King of all! Jesus ascends to Heaven so that He can sit at the right hand

of the Father where eventually He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead. Does this language sound familiar? It's from the Nicene Creed that we profess every single week at Mass! This truth of our faith is so essentially important that we literally speak it every single week.

Ultimately this solemnity reminds us that although we can face incredibly difficult times in our lives and everything can seem dark, we know that we have Our Lord in Heaven watching over us. Jesus did not abandon His apostles and He will never abandon us. He sits on His sovereign throne in Heaven waiting for each and every one of us to turn to Him in all we do!


