Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

Last weekend we celebrated the gift of fatherhood and our fathers! We pray that God, our Heavenly Father, will grant His wisdom, strength and blessings to fathers everywhere as they continue to provide, protect and nourish their families (amen!)

On Pentecost weekend, parishes throughout the archdioceses began a gradual process of revamping the Pandemic protocols that were put in place to help us stay open safely. Since then, parishes have been engaged in the process of regaining a sense of normalcy by accommodating more worshippers at Mass, opening parish facilities for group/society meetings, and restoring more of the activities that were previously suspended temporarily, etc.

This trend of returning to a semblance of normalcy continues here in our own parish as well. Below is a quick summary of what to look for in the coming months:

- **Daily Mass Schedule:** starting from Thursday, July 1, we will resume the pre-pandemic daily Mass schedule: 7AM Mass at the chapel of Our Lady of Guadalupe; 12:10 Noon Mass at St. Mary's Cathedral Basilica; and 6PM Mass in Spanish on Wednesdays ONLY;
- **Confessions:**
 - * Wednesdays, 4:30PM to 5:30 PM at St. Patrick's;
 - * Saturdays, 3:30 PM to 4:30 PM at St. Patrick's;
 - * Saturdays, 6:30 PM at Mary Star of the Sea Church;
 - * Sundays, 8:30 AM at Holy Rosary Church;
 - * Sundays, 10:30 AM at Sacred Heart Church; or
 - * Through appointment by calling the parish office
- **Anointing of the Sick:** Last Fridays of each month at the 12:10 Noon Mass at St. Mary's Cathedral-basilica.

We hope to resume the 24-hour Eucharistic Exposition and Adoration as soon as we get enough adorers to cover the hours. Please contact the parish office to sign up. Also, we will be resuming the Vocations' Cross Prayer ministry soon.

We are **one Holy Family Parish, united in the joy of the Holy Spirit and in charity, as missionary disciples, amen!**

Queridos amados en Cristo:

¡El fin de semana pasado celebramos el regalo de la paternidad y de nuestros padres! Oramos para que Dios, nuestro Padre Celestial, conceda Su sabiduría, fortaleza y bendiciones a los padres de todo el mundo mientras continúan proporcionando, protegiendo y alimentando a sus familias (¡amén!).

El fin de semana de Pentecostés, las parroquias de la arquidiócesis comenzaron un proceso gradual de modernización de los protocolos de la pandemia que se implementaron para ayudarnos a permanecer abiertos de manera segura. Desde entonces, las parroquias se han involucrado en el proceso de recuperar un sentido de normalidad acomodando a más fieles en la Misa, abriendo instalaciones parroquiales para reuniones de grupo / sociedad, y restaurando más actividades que antes estaban suspendidas temporalmente, etc.

Esta tendencia de volver a una apariencia de normalidad continúa aquí en nuestra propia parroquia también. A continuación se muestra un resumen rápido de lo que debe buscar en los próximos meses:

- **Horario de misas diarias:** a partir del jueves 1 de julio, reanudaremos el horario de misas diarias antes de la pandemia: misa de las 7 am en la capilla de Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe; 12:10 Misa del mediodía en la Basílica Catedral de Santa María; y Misa de las 6PM en español SOLAMENTE los miércoles;
- **Confesiones:**
 - * Los miércoles de 4:30 p.m. a 5:30 p.m. en St. Patrick's;
 - * Los sábados, de 3:30 p.m. a 4:30 p.m. en St. Patrick's;
 - * Los sábados a las 6:30 pm en la iglesia Mary Star of the Sea;
 - * Domingos, 8:30 AM en la Iglesia Holy Rosary;
 - * Domingos, 10:30 AM en la Iglesia del Sagrado Corazón; o
 - * Con cita previa llamando a la oficina parroquial
- **Unción de los enfermos:** los últimos viernes de cada mes en la misa del mediodía de las 12:10 en la catedral-basílica de Santa María.

Esperamos reanudar la Exposición Eucarística y Adoración de 24 horas tan pronto como tengamos suficientes adoradores para cubrir las horas. Comuníquese con la oficina parroquial para inscribirse. Además, pronto reanudaremos el ministerio de oración cruzada de vocaciones.

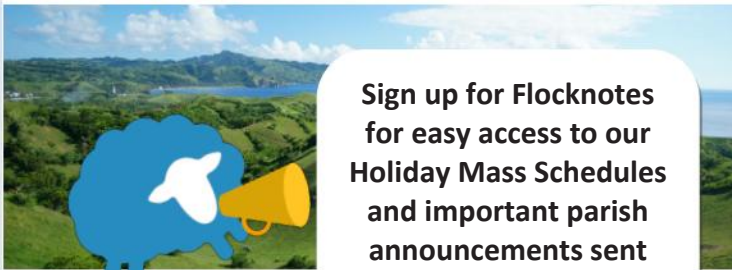
