Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

I am extremely grateful to Fr. Richard McNeille and the group of new seminarians who have been a part of our parish for the past six weeks. They came here for a propaedeutic program, designed to help new seminarians get a glimpse into the rigors of the formation program in the seminary.

During their stay, the seminarians have been engaged in various pastoral activities and ministries, as well as helping with a variety of maintenance work at our Holy Family school. Fr. Richard himself has been a great help to us, assisting with masses, confessions and visiting the sick and homebound. Taking their place at St. Patrick's rectory will be a group of young women, who are discerning a vocation to the Religious Life. Please keep all of them in your prayers. Pray, also, for an increase in holy vocation to the priesthood and the Religious Life.

The vocation of announcing the Good News of salvation in Christ Jesus is not reserved only for "professionals" such as priests, deacons and consecrated persons. Contrarily, it is one that we all share, each in his own capacity, by virtue of our baptism. Still, many of us are reluctant to engage in the work of evangelization, perhaps because we feel inadequate. Really, the work of evangelization simply buoys down to this truth – to daily live an authentically Christian life, which is centered on love of God and of neighbor.

There is no more convincing way to evangelize than to be authentically Christian in our everyday life! Pope Paul VI emphasized this truth clearly when he remarked that "Modern man listens more willingly to witnesses than to teachers, and if he does listen to teachers, it is because they are witnesses" (Evangelii Nuntiandi, #41). Or as the great St. Francis of Assisi puts it, preach the Gospel at all times and when necessary, use words!

With a deep sense of gratitude to Cardinal DiNardo and the archdiocese, I am glad to announce that the extensive repair works that begun in 2019 at St. Mary's Cathedral Basilica has finally been completed. The financial cost of this large scale work was about 3 million dollars (\$3,000,000.00), which was graciously provided by the archdiocese. See page 8 for snippets of the work done; of particular note are the additional two restrooms that were built in the old carriage room, behind the altar/sanctuary area. These restrooms can be accessed from outside the main church and a motorized lift makes them handicap accessible.

We are one Holy Family Parish, united in the joy of the Holy Spirit and in charity, as missionary disciples, amen!

Queridos amados en Cristo:

En su lugar en la rectoría de San Patricio habrá un grupo de mujeres jóvenes que están discerniendo una vocación a la vida religiosa. Por favor, manténgalos todos en sus oraciones. Ore también por un aumento de la santa vocación al sacerdocio y a la vida religiosa.

La vocación de anunciar la Buena Nueva de la salvación en Cristo Jesús no está reservada sólo a "profesionales" como sacerdotes, diáconos y consagrados. Por el contrario, es uno que todos compartimos, cada uno en su propia capacidad, en virtud de nuestro bautismo. Sin embargo, muchos de nosotros somos reacios a participar en la obra de evangelización, quizás porque nos sentimos inadecuados. Realmente, la obra de evangelización simplemente se impulsa hacia esta verdad: vivir diariamente una vida auténticamente cristiana, que se centra en el amor a Dios y al prójimo.

¡No hay forma más convincente de evangelizar que ser auténticamente cristianos en nuestra vida diaria! El Papa Pablo VI enfatizó claramente esta verdad cuando señaló que "el hombre moderno escucha con más gusto a los testigos que a los maestros, y si escucha a los maestros es porque son testigos" (*Evangelii Nuntiandi, n. 41*). O, como dice el gran San Francisco de Asís, *predica el Evangelio en todo momento y, cuando sea necesario, usa palabras.*

Con un profundo sentido de gratitud hacia el cardenal DiNardo y la arquidiócesis, me complace anunciar que las extensas obras de reparación que comenzaron en 2019 en la Basílica Catedral de Santa María finalmente se completaron. El costo financiero de este trabajo a gran escala fue de aproximadamente 3 millones de dólares (\$ 3,000,000.00), que fue gentilmente provisto por la arquidiócesis. Consulte la página 8 para ver fragmentos del trabajo realizado; De particular interés son los dos baños adicionales que se construyeron en la antigua sala de carruajes, detrás del área del altar / santuario. Se puede acceder a estos baños desde el exterior de la iglesia principal y un ascensor motorizado los hace accesibles para discapacitados.

Somos una parroquia de la Sagrada Familia, unidos en el gozo del Espíritu Santo y en la caridad, como discípulos misioneros, jamén!

Thank you for what we've accomplished at St. Mary's Cathedral Basilica:



BELL TOWER:

- -Refurbished the interior of the bell tower by adding lighting, bird protection, better rain drainage system, and opened the windows for a better view of the bell.
- -Restored the 1874 bell by replacing the failing mounts and updating the bell toller
- -Installed a new automatic electronic tolling system.
- -Refurbished the base for the Mary Statue by reinforcing the rotted wood and replacing the aging copper coverings.
- -Reconstructed new wooden stairway to the bell.



-Restored the statue by completely removing all the old paint, repairing old cracks, repainting with a high-quality paint, gold leafed the crown, and fitting the statue with better mounting anchors.

ROOF CROSSES:

-Restored the crosses with new anchors and replaced corroded copper pieces.

SPIRES:

- -Replaced corroded and failing copper spire tops.
- -Replaced the rotting wood structure under the tops with a new steel substructure.
- -Installed a new entry into the southside spire to allow for better inspections.

ROOF:

-Improved the roof drainage system to allow better flow of water off of the roof.

WALLS:

- -Resealed leaks in the wall and repaired
- -Repainted scuffed lower areas of the inside walls

STAINED GLASS WINDOWS:

- -Refurbished all of the stained glass windows in the church.
- -Installed a higher-quality hurricane proof covering.

DOORS:

- -Restored front doors
- -Replaced handicapped door
- -Restored carriage house doors

-Installed new automatic openers on both the handicapped door and carriage house doors.

CARRIAGE HOUSE:

- -Installed two new bathrooms, including an ADA compliant certified bathroom.
- -Installed new carpeting.
- -Installed a new wheelchair lift.
- -Installed a new automatic lighting system.
- -Replaced concrete leading to the doors in order to allow for better drainage and meet ADA requirements.
- -Created two new handicapped parking spaces for better access to the carriage house.

ORGAN:

- -Moved several organ parts for better access to inspection areas.
- -Refurbished several parts of the organ.

INTERIOR SUBFLOOR:

-Sealed crawl space in order to allow for a more efficient use of the air conditioners.

AIR CONDITIONERS:

- -Installed seven new air conditioners.
- -Installed new automated controls for the A/C system that allows for better monitoring of the health and usage of the A/C components.

LIGHTING:

- -Upgraded all the lighting in the interior of the church with new LED lights.
- -Upgraded the lighting control switches.
- -Installed new lighting for the statue, front stained glass windows, and front plaques.

KNEELERS:

-Reupholstered all the kneelers

FRONT:

-Gold leafed the 1847 plaque on the front of the church.

INSPECTIONS:

- -Scanned the spires to set a base point for future inspections on the spires lean.
- -Performed a smoke test on the interior of the church in order to find any leaks in the walls.
- -Performed soil analysis to determine the soil contents under the church foundation.




