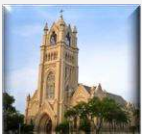

Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

Happy anniversary! It was on the 15th of August, 2009, that Cardinal DiNardo created the new Holy Family Parish, to serve all the Catholic faithful on the island, after the devastation caused by Hurricane Ike in September of 2008. Twelve years later, we continue to flourish as *one Holy Family Parish, united in the joy of the Holy Spirit and in charity, as missionary disciples*.

August 15th is the **Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary**. The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary affirms that the Mother of God, after the course of her earthly life, was assumed body and soul into heavenly glory. This is a divinely revealed dogma, which means it requires our assent of faith. The feast of the Assumption is a holy day of obligation. It underscores the truth that the Blessed Virgin Mary is united with her Son so intimately and so shares in His victory over death. For us, it is an affirmation of our hope in the gift of resurrection.

How providential that the founding of our parish is linked to this great feast of the Blessed Virgin Mary! It is as though we are invited to look beyond the ravages of death and all that threatens life – as in the case of Hurricane Ike – and to see what lies beyond for all whose faith is in God. Let us therefore make it a habit to ask for the grace of renewal in our parish, through the intercessions of the Blessed Virgin Mary.

This weekend, also, we welcome the **Congregation of the Missionaries of St. Charles** (a.k.a., the **Scalabrinians**) to our parish. They are here to participate in the annual **Missionary Cooperative Plan** of the archdiocese. Through the Missionary Cooperative Plan, the lay faithful are introduced to the wider missionary activities of the Church and are given the opportunity to participate in them through their support.

The Scalabrinians were founded by Blessed John Baptiste Scalabrini (1839-1905) on November 28, 1887 to provide pastoral ministry to migrants and refugees. They are currently serving in thirty-two different countries in five continents! We will be taking up a second collection at all the Masses this weekend to help provide needed support to their missionary endeavors. Thank you for your great generosity.

Through the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary, may we continue to grow as **one Holy Family Parish, united in the joy of the Holy Spirit and in charity, as missionary disciples, amen!**

Mensaje del Pastor

Queridos amados en Cristo:

¡Feliz aniversario! Fue el 15 de agosto de 2009 que el Cardenal DiNardo creó la nueva Parroquia de la Sagrada Familia, para servir a todos los fieles católicos de la isla, después de la devastación causada por el huracán Ike en septiembre de 2008. Doce años después, seguimos floreciendo. como una parroquia de la Sagrada Familia, unidos en la alegría del Espíritu Santo y en la caridad, como discípulos misioneros.

El 15 de agosto es la **solemnidad de la Asunción de la Santísima Virgen María**. La Asunción de la Santísima Virgen María afirma que la Madre de Dios, después del transcurso de su vida terrena, fue asumida en cuerpo y alma a la gloria celestial. Este es un dogma divinamente revelado, lo que significa que requiere nuestro asentimiento de fe. La fiesta de la Asunción es un día de precepto. Haremos una segunda colecta en todas las misas este fin de semana para ayudar a brindar el apoyo necesario a sus esfuerzos misioneros. Gracias por tu gran generosidad.

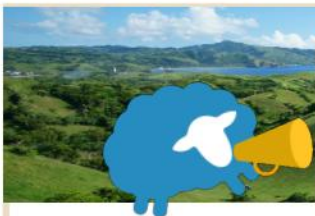

All Students who have completed 2 years of Youth Group and are preparing for the Sacrament of Confirmation this October are expected to attend with their parents and a copy of the student's baptism certificate.

Children's Catechumenate –RCIC – Rite of Christian Initiation of Children who have Reached Catechetical Age. (7 years old or older)

This is a two-year program (process) for children who were not baptized as infants, who have attained the age of reason, are of catechetical age, and who will participate in the Rite of Christian Initiation at the Easter Vigil.

The Children will attend weekly age- appropriate classes and parents will attend Sacrament Preparation Meetings periodically as required. The candidates will celebrate the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist) at the Easter vigil of their second year.

The First year (stage) of the faith journey is called the inquiry. Classes are centered on God, and God's love. They cover basic questions in the areas of Catholic Belief, Mass, the Bible, saints, prayer, and practices. This is a time for inquires to learn the ways Catholics worship together and how they bring their Christian faith to life. This stage culminates with the commitment to enter the catechumenate, to prepare for entrance into full membership with the Catholic Church.

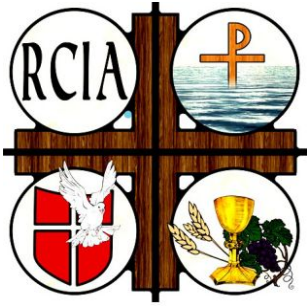
The second year (stage) of classes emphasizes the child's relationship with God, and their families within the body of Christ, the Church. The process will continue with the Catechumenate, Lent and Mystagogy stages. A sponsor accompanies the child on his/her journey. All sponsors must fulfill Diocesan requirements.

- Registration for first year (stage) requires to fill out registration form
- Registration for second year, requires to fill out registration forms and bring a copy of your child's birth certificate.

During the two years, special sessions are held to help children, families, sponsors prepare for the celebration of the Sacraments of initiation, and parents are required to attend mandatory parent session and retreat.

The celebration of the Sacraments of initiation takes place during the Easter Vigil of the second year. The Candidates then begin a period of reflection on the initiation process called mystagogy where they reflect on the sacraments celebrated and continue to grow in their faith.

BAPTISM



"You must be born again with water AND the spirit," said Jesus to Nicodemus. This has always meant the believers must be baptized, because that is where water and the spirit come together to make us a new creation in Christ. Water and the spirit previously came together in Genesis 1:2 to create the world, in Genesis 8:11 to Noah for the new world after the flood, and in Exodus 14:24-25 to give the Israelites the new Promised Land!



Mark 16:6: He who believes and is baptized will be saved.

Acts 22:16: And now why do you wait? Rise and be baptized, and wash away your sins, calling on his name.

Romans 6:3: Do you not know that all of us who have been baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death?

1 Peter 3:21: Baptism, which corresponds to this, now saves you, not as a removal of dirt from the body but as an appeal to God for a clear conscience, through the resurrection of Jesus Christ.

Baptism is NOT just some kind of ceremonial initiation rite into Christianity. We know from scripture that it saves us from hell, it washes away our sins, and it enables us to share in both his death and resurrection!
