Meet our New Seminarian!

Greetings to the Holy Family Parish community! My name is **Viet Nguyen**. I am a seminarian for the Archdiocese of Galveston-Houston and I will be with you this academic year to minster to you and to learn how to be a great future priest through the guidance and supervision of your venerable pastor, Fr. Jude Ezuma. I am 34 years old and was born and raised in Houston. My parents were refugees to America from Vietnam after its fall to the Communists in 1975. I have one little sister who will be married later this year and one little brother who has just started his seminary formation for our Archdiocese.

Before entering seminary, I graduated from Texas A&M University with a bachelor's in Biology in 2010. At that time, I wanted to be a dentist, but my grades were not competitive for dental school. Thus, I applied and got into the Dental Hygiene program at Houston Community College. After two years, I became a Registered Dental Hygienist (R.D.H.) and worked in various dental offices around the greater Houston area for five years.

During these five years, a few things happened. I dated a woman for over 3 years in which, during a short break in our relationship, she was diagnosed with cancer and died shortly after. A deep reflection upon her life, death, and our relationship encouraged me to be a better Catholic man. I began to attend daily mass and teach RCIA at my parish and found great joy in both. At this time, God also taught me that dentistry was not something I wanted to do for the rest of my life.

With all these factors, along with a call to consider the priesthood from the vocation director of the Archdiocese during a summer young adult event, I responded to God's call to enter the seminary. I have just finished my fourth year at St. Mary's Seminary in Houston. With great joy and trust in what God has in store for this "Pastoral Year" of mine, I look forward to meeting and loving each one of you as I accompany you on our mutual journey towards the Kingdom of God.


