

Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

I am glad to announce that after a long hiatus, which was caused by the ongoing pandemic, we will finally resume our parish **Vocation Cross** prayer ministry this weekend! This ministry was the brainchild of our parish **Stewardship and Evangelization Committee** and is aimed at responding to the invitation of Christ to *ask the Lord of the harvest to send laborers to his harvest*! Catecumenado de Niños - RCIC - Rito de Iniciación Cristiana de Niños que han alcanzado la edad catequética. (7 años o más)

Este es un programa (proceso) de dos años para niños que no fueron bautizados de infantes, que han alcanzado la edad de razón, son catequéticos y participarán en el Rito de Iniciación Cristiana en la Vigilia Pascual.

Los niños asistirán a clases semanales apropiadas para su edad y los padres asistirán a las reuniones de preparación sacramental periódicamente según sea necesario. Los candidatos celebrarán los sacramentos de iniciación (bautismo, confirmación y eucaristía) en la vigilia pascual de su segundo año.

El primer año (etapa) de la jornada de fe se llama indagación. Las clases se centran en Dios y el amor de Dios. Cubren preguntas básicas en las áreas de Creencia Católica, Misa, Biblia, santos, oración y prácticas. Este es un momento para que las preguntas aprendan las formas en que los católicos adoran juntos y cómo dan vida a su fe cristiana. Esta etapa culmina con el compromiso de ingresar al catecumenado, para prepararse para ingresar a la membresía plena de la Iglesia Católica.

El segundo año (etapa) de clases enfatiza la relación del niño con Dios y sus familias dentro del cuerpo de Cristo, la Iglesia. El proceso continuará con las etapas de Catecumenado, Cuaresma y Mistagogía. Un padrino acompaña al niño en su viaje. Todos los patrocinadores deben cumplir con los requisitos diocesanos.

- La inscripción para el primer año (etapa) requiere completar el formulario de inscripción
- Inscripción para el segundo año, requiere completar formularios de inscripción y traer una copia del certificado de nacimiento de su hijo.

Durante los dos años, se llevan a cabo sesiones especiales para ayudar a los niños, las familias y los padrinos a prepararse para la celebración de los sacramentos de iniciación, y se requiere que los padres asistan a la sesión y al retiro obligatorio para padres.

La celebración de los sacramentos de iniciación tiene lugar durante la Vigilia Pascual del segundo año. Luego, los Candidatos comienzan un período de reflexión sobre el proceso de iniciación llamado Mistagogía donde reflexionan sobre los sacramentos celebrados y continúan creciendo en su fe.

As you know, tens of thousands of Afghan families are fleeing their country to escape retaliation from the Taliban. Because they worked alongside American troops, diplomats and government officials they are now targets. They're our friends

and are now seeking refuge in the country they risked everything to help. Many will be coming to Houston, and because of our long history and expertise in refugee resettlement, Catholic Charities will be a major player in helping resettle these families.
