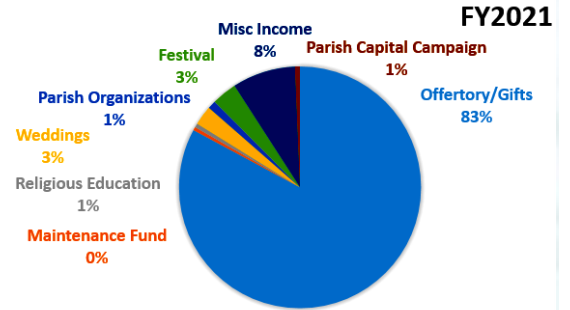

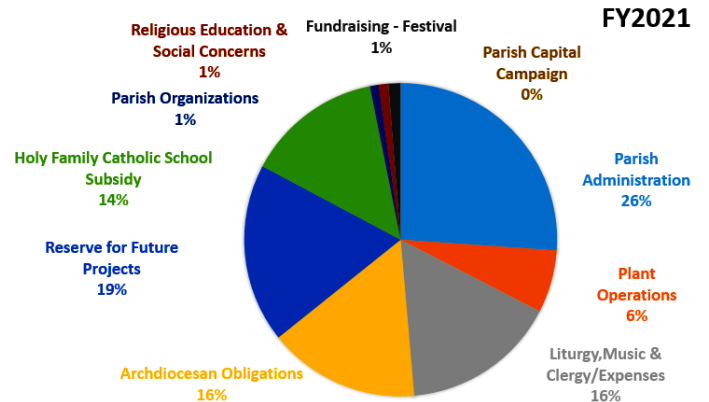

St. Mary's Cathedral Basilica: Reupholstered kneelers, tuned piano; restored 1874 Bell and mounts; installed new tolling system; added lighting, bird protection, improved drainage systems; restored roof crosses; completed restoration of lighting; repaired walls; completed stained glass renovations and hurricane covers; installed new automatic door openers for handicap door and carriage house doors; installed 7 new air conditioners and new controls, updated switches and all interior lighting with LEDs, installed new lighting for statue, stained glass windows, and front plaques; and gold leafed the 1847 plaque

Carriage House at St. Mary's: Installed two new bathrooms, including an ADA compliant certified bathroom; new carpeting; new wheelchair lift; new automatic lighting system; replaced concrete leading to the doors in order to allow for better drainage and meet ADA requirements; created two new handicapped parking spaces for better access to the carriage house

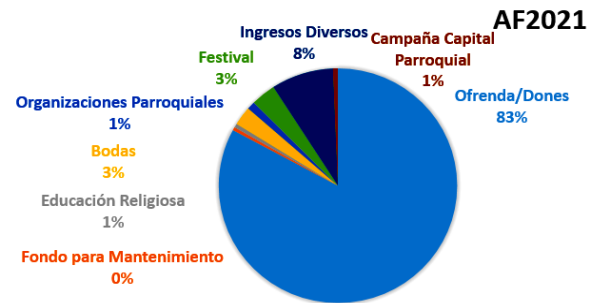

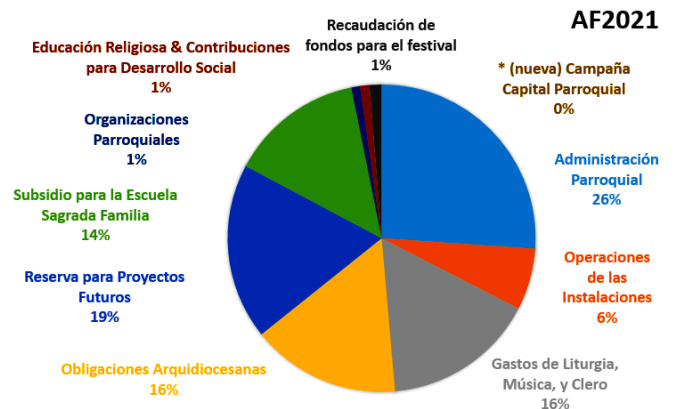

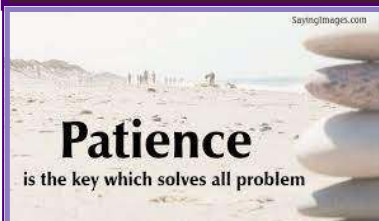
