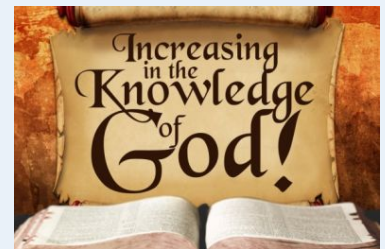

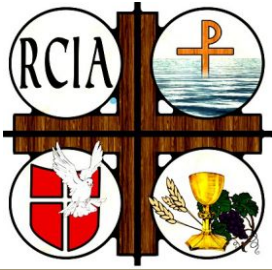
TASKS OF CATECHESIS

Catechesis promotes knowledge of Faith

The initial introduction of the Gospel introduces one to Christ for the first time and invites conversion. Through the action of divine providence and the Holy Spirit, such encounters engender in the hearer the desires to know about Jesus. God is Here

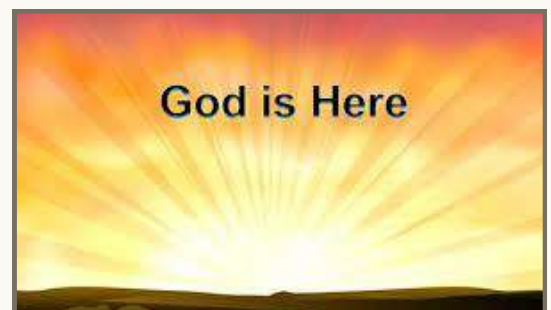
God has come to stay with us and from the look of things, He is not going anywhere anytime soon. The last words of Christ to His apostles before He went back to heaven were, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me; go therefore, and make disciples of all nations. Baptizing them in the name of Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Teach them to carry out everything I have commanded you. *Know that I AM with you always, until the end of the world.*"

I told you at the beginning that God has come to stay. Remember His name again- EMMANUEL meaning "GOD WITH US." Not God with me only, but God with us. It reminds us that the whole heaven which is God's throne, His angels and Archangels, and all who enjoy the beautiful presence of God are with us daily.

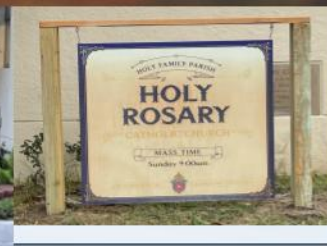
