### TASKS OF CATECHESIS

Catechesis promotes knowledge of the meaning of the liturgy and the sacraments.

Since Christ is present in the sacraments, the person comes to know Christ in the liturgical celebrations of the Church and he or she is drawn into communion with him. Christ saving action is in the paschal mystery as celebrated in the sacraments, especially the Eucharist. Catechesis promotes an active, conscious, genuine participation and by forming the minds of the faithful. Sacramental catechesis prepares for the initial celebration of the sacraments and provides enrichment following their reception.

### The Church, the Body of Christ

The Catholic Church was founded by Christ when He asked His apostle, "who do people say I am" - Matthew 16. The reply from the apostle I think, was amazing. They started with John the Baptist, then Elijah, Jeremiah, and even added that one of the prophets. Then looking into their eyes. Jesus asked "Who do you say I am?" That was a direct question and it actually needed a direct answer. Peter's answer calmed the tension that day, and changed the whole situation forever. "You are Peter and upon this rock, I will build my Church, and the gate of the nether world shall not prevail against it." -Matthew 16:17. God the Father gave Peter the hint. How lucky are you Peter to listen and understand the voice of God speaking to you about this beautiful Church of God.

We are the Church built and nourished by Christ Himself and that is the reason we are still standing tall considering all that the Church has undergone over the centuries. We are the body of Christ. Yes, Christ Jesus is our Head and we are all members of His Body. Saint Paul explained it very well in his first letter to the Corinthians 12 from verses 12: "The body is one and has many members, but all the members, many though, they are one body; so it is with Christ."

Every one of us is as important as the other in the Church and as Saint James advised, we should not look down on anyone- James 2. Just as the eye is as important as the leg and hand, so too the one who hands out the bulletin every Sunday is as important as the one who sings and reads at Holy Mass. Together we make up the Church which is the Body of Christ.

We are all united as one body in the Holy Eucharist - the nourishing Body and Blood of Jesus Christ which we strive as believers to receive almost everyday. So, let us work together to keep the flame on and the spirit aglow, so that the Church of Christ Jesus our Lord which was handed down to us by the apostles and has survived all the persecution and trials over the years, will be far better than what we met when we are no more. Amen.
