#### **JOSEPH TEACHES HIS SON THE CARPENTRY TRADE**

Joseph was the earthly father of Jesus, the man entrusted to raise the Son of God. When Joseph took Mary as his wife, people laughed and made fun of him, because he was marrying a woman who was already pregnant, and it was not his child. Brave St. Joseph ignored those people and obeyed God in the face of severe humiliation. Joseph was a morally upright man; he was a kind and sensitive nan. Joseph loved and guided Jesus as only a good father can. These noble qualities made him God's choice for the Messiah's earthly father.

The Bible does not reveal much detail about Joseph's role as the father of Jesus Christ, but we know he was an excellent earthly example of integrity and righteousness. Joseph was last mentioned in Scripture, when Jesus was 12 years old.

Joseph was a carpenter. He passed on the carpentry trade to his son and raised Him in the Jewish traditions and spiritual observances.

Jesus did not begin His earthly ministry until He was 30 years old. Until then, He supported Mary with the carpentry trade, the occupation Joseph had taught and equipped Him with.


