



The Cross: Our Tree of Life

The Cross is the symbol of our salvation; it is the tree of life on which our savior and redeemer gave up His life for sinful humanity. "My Father, if it is possible, let this cup pass me by. Still, let it be as You would have it, not as I" (Matthew 26:39). What a prayer from God to God. I have never thought of that. God the Son who is One with the Father, begotten not made, consubstantial with the Father and through Whom all things were made, surrenders to the Father's will for our salvation by dying on the cross! For us men and women born with original sin and the sins we ourselves have committed, He came down from His throne high in heaven, gave His precious life in order to save us. Why is it so difficult to fully understand that Jesus came because he loves and cares, and everything He went through was for me?

Saint Paul's reflection on Christ's obedience to the Father explains everything. "Though He was in the form of God, He did not deem equality with God something to be grasped at. Rather, He emptied Himself and took the form of a slave, being born in the likeness of men. He was known to be of human estate, and it was thus that He humbled Himself, obediently accepting even death, death on a cross" (Philippians 2:6-8).

Yes, He accepted death on a shameful cross. Though shameful and despicable, the cross has been transformed into the universal symbol of salvation because of Christ. To those who crucified Christ, the cross was the most shameful death and they were happy that they did it; but for us His followers, it is the tree of life.

We love the cross, we love the One who was crucified on the cross, we love and cherish the old rugged cross on which hung the savior of the world. For us Christians, it was not merely a shameful death, but the redeeming death through which we have life in abundance.

In the words of Padre Pio: "Anyone who wants to be a true Christian, must mortify his flesh for no other reason than devotion to Jesus, Who, for love of us, mortified His entire body on the cross." Christ has made the cross beautiful. When we unite our sufferings with his, they become redemptive and beautiful.

Jesus meek and humble of heart, make our hearts like unto thine. Amen.


