## God Our Help

"I look up to the mountain. From where shall come my help? My help comes from the Lord, who made heaven and earth" (Psalm 121:1-2). After Saint Peter experienced God's mercy and help, he addressed his Jewish brothers saying, "There is no other name under heaven by which men can be saved except the name of Jesus" (Acts 4:12).
