

The Humanity of God the Son

Prophet Isaiah prophesied about the coming of the Son of God in Isaiah 7:14, "Therefore the Lord himself shall give you a sign: Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a son and shall call his name Immanuel." A name which means, "God is with us." Everything said about Christ in the Old Testament was fulfilled in the New Testament. He came from the descendant of David meaning He was of a kingly lineage. He was born of a virgin full of grace (Luke 1:28). The Word of God became flesh and dwells among us and we saw His glory (John 1:14). The Word of God (Jesus Christ) was with God from the beginning. John explained that all things came to be through Him and without Him, nothing would have been. God the Son was present at the beginning of creation. He took on our humanity and became for us the Light that shines through our darkness and in His light, we all see light (Psalm 36:10).

Jesus is the purest Lamb who came for the purpose of our salvation. Through Him, we have confidence to call God Father. He is our mediator who is at the right hand of God the Father, interceding for us; the true Lamb of God who has reconciled the entire human race to the Blessed Trinity. We can now approach the throne of grace because Christ offered Himself once and for all for the redemption of our souls. He became the priest, the victim, and the sacrifice (Hebrew 7:27).

Who then can separate us from the love of God? Now we believe that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is made perfect in Christ Jesus our Lord (Romans 8:38-39). In taking our nature, he manifests, in his flesh, the boundless love of God for us. In his humanity, he identifies with us "in all things but sin" and invites us to trust because he understands and sympathizes with us in our struggles (Hebrews 4:15).


Feast Day of All Carmelite Saints


