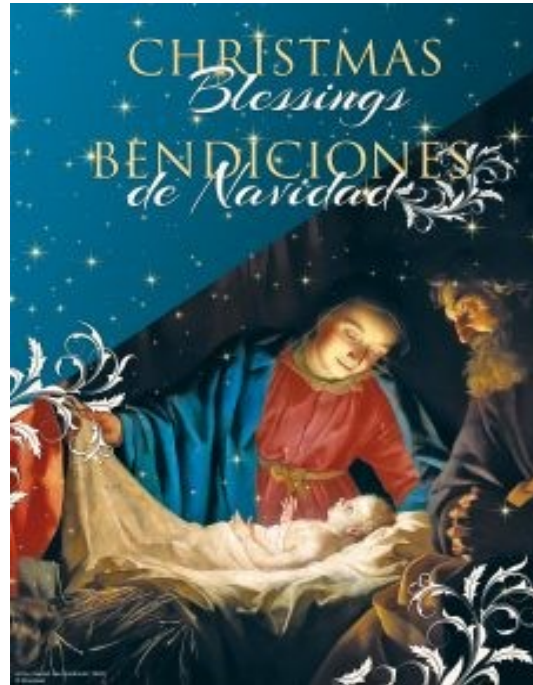

Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

I wish you all a truly blessed and Merry Christmas! We thank God for this moment, for in spite of the innumerable challenges and hardships that have plagued us globally, we are here today to celebrate the truth that God is always with us. Emmanuel, God with us – what a consoling reminder to all of humanity of God's steadfast love for us His children!

The events of recent history may have made many of us to question whether God is truly with us. The Christmas story and proclamation is a powerful reminder of God's steadfast love for all of creation. Jesus, whose name means 'Savior', came to save the world. Even at the time of his birth, the shadow of the cross was already looming as seen, especially in Herod's diabolical intentions against the new born king, which ultimately resulted in the massacre of innocent children (see: **Matthew 2:13-18**). Muy amados en Cristo:

¡Les deseo a todos una feliz y bendecida Navidad! Agradecemos a Dios por este momento, porque a pesar de los innumerables desafíos y dificultades que nos han plagado globalmente, estamos aquí hoy para celebrar la verdad de que Dios siempre está con nosotros. Emmanuel, Dios con nosotros, ¡qué recordatorio consolador para toda la humanidad del amor inquebrantable de Dios por nosotros, Sus hijos!

Los acontecimientos de la historia reciente pueden haber hecho que muchos de nosotros nos cuestionemos si Dios está verdaderamente con nosotros. La historia y la proclamación de la Navidad son un poderoso recordatorio del amor inquebrantable de Dios por toda la creación. Jesús, cuyo nombre significa "Salvador", vino a salvar al mundo. 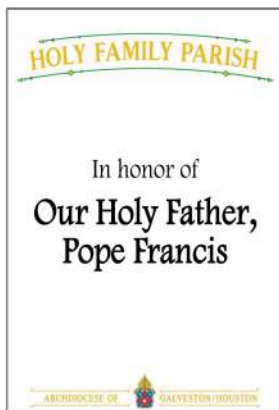
