Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

The Church celebrates the **Baptism of the Lord** today. Christ's baptism is also a moment of Epiphany because after Jesus "had been baptized and was praying, heaven was opened and the Holy Spirit descended upon him in bodily form like a dove. And a voice came from heaven, "You are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased" (from today's Gospel – **Luke 3:21-22**). This truth, revealed by the Father of His Son and confirmed by the Holy Spirit, also testifies to our divine heritage namely, that through baptism, we are made into children of God and heirs of the kingdom.

At Mass today we will have the opportunity to renew our baptismal promises. I am also very delighted to announce that we have restored the holy water fonts at the entrances to all the churches, in line with the latest pandemic protocols that were recently issued by Cardinal DiNardo for parishes throughout the archdiocese. See below for more of the pandemic protocol updates:

- The general dispensation from the Sunday and Holy Day Mass obligations has been removed, effective January 2nd, 2022. All faithful are required to joyfully fulfill the Sunday and Holy Day obligations. One may be exempted from this obligation only due to illness or when prevented from fulfilling it due to advanced age or when providing care for a sick person. Even then, we are required to fulfill this obligation through some act of prayer, charity and meditation on the sacred scriptures for the Mass of the day;
- The suspension of receiving the Precious Blood from a common chalice is still in effect until further notice; and
- We will continue giving a sign of peace at Mass using appropriate gestures such as a bow or even a friendly fist bump for those who feel comfortable offering/receiving it.

Let us continue to pray for an end to the global pandemic, for health and recovery to all those who are sick, and for the safety and wellbeing of all those who continue to provide care in the public sphere, amen!

We are one Holy Family Parish, united in the joy of the Holy Spirit and in charity, as missionary disciples, amen!

Uno puede estar exento de esta obligación sólo debido a una enfermedad o cuando se le impida cumplirla debido a la edad avanzada o cuando se preste atención a una persona enferma. Incluso entonces, estamos obligados a cumplir con esta obligación a través de algún acto de oración, caridad y meditación sobre las sagradas escrituras para la Misa del día;
- La suspensión de recibir la Preciosa Sangre de un cáliz común sigue vigente hasta nuevo aviso; v
- Continuaremos dando una señal de paz en la Misa usando gestos apropiados como un arco o incluso un golpe de puño amistoso para aquellos que se sienten cómodos ofreciéndolo / recibiéndolo.

THE BAPTISM OF THE LORD

The baptism of the Lord marks the beginning of Jesus' public life and the end of the Christmas season. Jesus was baptized by His cousin and forerunner- John. 




