Dearly Beloved in Christ:

Last year in October, Pope Francis convoked the 16th General Assembly of the Synod of Bishops, which is scheduled to take place in Rome in October of 2023. The Holy Father officially opened the Synod on the weekend of October 9-10 and asked bishops throughout the world to do the same with as much participation of the faithful as possible on the following weekend. Cardinal DiNardo inaugurated its official opening in our archdiocese on Wednesday October 20th during a Mass that was livestreamed.

What is peculiar about this Synod is that the Pope wants it to include, not just the bishops of the world, but indeed all of the Faithful. This fact is clearly underscored in the theme the Holy Father chose for the synod, namely: "For a Synodal Church: Communion, Participation and Mission".

Also, that the Synod (i.e., meeting of Bishops) is set to take place in October of 2023 in Rome is because the Pope is asking diocesan bishops throughout the world to hold listening sessions with the faithful in their respective dioceses. The summary of these listening sessions will in turn be sent to Rome, through the respective regional Conferences of Bishops, in preparation for the Synod in 2023.

Cardinal DiNardo has set up an Ad-Hoc Committee, consisting of members of the Archdiocesan Pastoral Council and a few chancery staff to help with the implementation of the directives of the Holy Father for the synodal process. They, in turn, have prepared a simplified guide for the use of parishes to conduct listening sessions.

The word "synod" is derived from two Greek words – sun and hodus, "sunhodos" – which means to "walk together". The Church, by nature is synodal and we see this very evidently in the Acts of the Apostles (see, for instance, the Council of Jerusalem in Acts 15:1 -35) and throughout the history of the Church.

Cardinal DiNardo reminds all the faithful of our archdiocese that this synod is about discerning together and listening to the Holy Spirit, as we journey with Christ toward everlasting salvation. We will be publishing the dates and times for listening sessions in our parish through regular announcements. The Pope is calling for this Synod because he wants to hear from all the faithful, both clergy and lay; we hope that you can participate in this journey of faith

We are one Holy Family Parish, united in the joy of the Holy Spirit and in charity, as missionary disciples, amen!

Mensaje del Pastor

Amado en Cristo:

El año pasado, en octubre, el Papa Francisco convocó la XVI Asamblea General del Sínodo de los Obispos, que está programada para octubre de 2023 en Roma. El Santo Padre inauguró oficialmente el Sínodo el fin de semana del 9 y 10 de octubre y pidió a los obispos de todo mundo a hacer lo mismo con la mayor participación posible de los fieles el fin de semana siguiente. El cardenal DiNardo inauguró su inauguración oficial en nuestra arquidiócesis el miércoles 20 de octubre durante una misa que se transmitió vivo. en Lo peculiar de este Sínodo es que el Papa quiere que incluya, no solo a los obispos del mundo, sino a todos los Fieles. Este hecho está claramente subravado en el tema elegido por el Santo Padre para el sínodo, a saber: "Por una Iglesia sinodal: comunión. participación misión". Además, que el Sínodo (es decir, la reunión de obispos) se celebre en octubre de 2023 en Roma se debe a que el Papa está pidiendo a los obispos diocesanos de todo el mundo que celebren sesiones de escucha con los fieles en sus respectivas diócesis. El resumen de estas sesiones de escucha se enviará a su vez a Roma, a través de las respectivas Conferencias regionales de obispos, en preparación Sínodo para el de 2023. El Cardenal DiNardo ha establecido un Comité Ad-Hoc, compuesto por miembros del Consejo Pastoral Arquidiocesano y algunos miembros del personal de la cancillería para ayudar con la implementación de las directivas del Santo Padre para el proceso sinodal. Ellos, a su vez, han preparado una guía simplificada para el uso de las parroquias para realizar sesiones de escucha.

La palabra "sínodo" se deriva de dos palabras griegas: sol y hodus, "sunhodos", que significa "caminar juntos". La Iglesia, por naturaleza es sinodal y esto lo vemos muy claramente en los Hechos de los Apóstoles (ver, por ejemplo, el Concilio de Jerusalén en Hechos 15:1-35) ya lo largo de la historia de la Iglesia.

El cardenal DiNardo recuerda a todos los fieles de nuestra arquidiócesis que este sínodo se trata de discernir juntos y escuchar al Espíritu Santo, mientras caminamos con Cristo hacia la salvación eterna. Publicaremos las fechas y horas de las sesiones de escucha en nuestra parroquia a través de anuncios regulares. El Papa convoca este Sínodo porque quiere escuchar a todos los fieles, tanto clérigos como laicos; Esperamos que puedas participar en este camino de fe.

Somos una parroquia de la Sagrada Familia, unidos en la alegría del Espíritu Santo y en la caridad, como discípulos misioneros, jamén!

RCIA- A Call to Discipleship

RCIA is adult faith formation, which is aimed at forming life-long disciples for Christ, committed to living out the truth as taught by the Catholic Church. Through RCIA, the Church is able to make more disciples to help in the work of evangelization and fulfill the mission of Jesus Christ (Mark 16:15). RCIA creates an environment for hearing God's word. We are all called to turn away from our sins, experience the mercy of God, and be drawn into the mystery of God's love which is made manifest in Jesus Christ our Lord.

As companions on the journey of faith, we are called to be evangelizers. Just as we ourselves have been evangelized, we are called to continue the work of evangelization. By virtue of our baptism, we are priests and prophets, a people chosen by God to announce His goodness to the entire world. God has called us through Jesus Christ His Son from the darkness of our sins into His wonderful light. Once we were no people at all, but now through the redemptive power of Jesus our Lord and Master, we are God's people and we enjoy God's mercy (See: 1 Peter 2:9-10).

So then, as followers of Christ, we are called to do what He did and live out the mission of the Church for which He gave His life. We are to show others by our lives that the kingdom of God is right here within us and with us. Christ has left us an example to follow in His footsteps through the Beatitudes and the Commandments: to love God and others, and treat others as we would want them to treat us (Cf. Luke 6:31). Everything we need to make us good disciples are found in the Bible and the teaching of the Church.

We are called to reach out to and build the faith of the people of God by living good lives and being our brothers and sisters' keepers. Let us turn our lives toward God the maker of all things and conform ourselves and our wills to the will of Christ, so that people will come to know God more and more through the way we live our Christ-like lives.






