# MY LORD AND MY GOD

Jesus said to Thomas, "Have you come to believe because you have seen me? Blessed are those who have not seen and yet believed" (see John 20:29). We are the most blessed because we believe that God the Son was born of a virgin and lived among us, though without sin. He preached about the kingdom of heaven and what we need to do and how we should live our lives to gain heaven. He was condemned by his own people, the same people he came to save, and was crucified and died for our sake.


