## *Message from the Pastor*

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

I was in High School when I first heard the phrase, *mens sana in corpore sano*, which is attributed to the first century Roman poet, Juvenal. The phrase means: "a healthy mind in a healthy body", and was one that was often thrown around by our PE instructor as a way to encourage our participation in some of his gruesome exercises. We all know the importance of physical health and how it can impact the quality of one's lifestyle.

In light of the above, I am very pleased to announce that the Sisters of the Daughters of Mary Mother of Mercy (DMMM) will be in our parish to share with us about their Mobile Life-Saving Health Ministry initiatives. At each of the Masses this weekend, a member of the DMMM Sisters will be speaking with us about this ministry, through which they offer radiation-free and ultrasound health screening of the following organs: thyroid, carotid arteries, liver, kidneys, gallbladder, aorta and spleen. Let us take advantage of this service. See the bulletin for more information.

The Congregation of the Daughters of Mary Mother of Mercy was founded by the late Bishop Anthony Gogo Nwedo, CSSP, on December 29, 1961. As the first bishop of the newly created Catholic Diocese of Umuahia, eastern Nigeria, Bishop Nwedo resorted to building schools, mission hospitals and orphanages as a way to carry out the work of evangelization. To help run these institutions and further the work of evangelization, Bishop Nwedo, with the blessing of Rome, founded this congregation. Since their founding, they have flourished in their ministry and today, they have sisters who are serving in Europe, North America as well as in several parts of Nigeria. As we take advantage of their Mobile Health Life-Saving ministry, let us remember to pray for God's blessings on their members and their apostolate.

On this first weekend in February, we continue our parish ministry of praying for an increase of holy vocations to the priesthood and the Religious Life through the Vocations Cross prayer ministry. We are very grateful to parishioners who continue to heed the invitation of our Savior, Jesus Christ to ask the Lord of the harvest to send laborers to his harvest (Matthew 9:38).

La Congregación de las Hijas de María Madre de la Misericordia fue fundada por el difunto obispo Anthony Gogo Nwedo, CSSP, el 29 de diciembre de 1961. Como primer obispo de la recién creada diócesis católica de Umuahia, al este de Nigeria, el obispo Nwedo recurrió a la construcción de escuelas, hospitales de misión y orfanatos como forma de llevar a cabo la obra de evangelización. Para ayudar a administrar estas instituciones y promover el trabajo de evangelización, el obispo Nwedo, con la bendición de Roma, fundó esta congregación. Desde su fundación, han florecido en su ministerio y hoy en día tienen hermanas que están sirviendo en Europa, América del Norte y en varias partes de Nigeria. Mientras aprovechamos su ministerio de Salvamento de Vida de Salud Móvil, recordemos orar por las bendiciones de Dios sobre sus miembros y su apostolado.

En este primer fin de semana de febrero, continuamos con nuestro ministerio parroquial de oración por un aumento de vocaciones santas al sacerdocio y la Vida Religiosa a través del ministerio de oración de la Cruz de las Vocaciones. Estamos muy agradecidos con los feligreses que siguen atendiendo la invitación de nuestro Salvador Jesucristo de pedirle al Señor de la mies que envíe obreros a su mies (Mateo 9:38).

### GOD SAW THAT IT WAS GOOD

Everything God created was created good, and the Creator of all things had an intention for everything He made. The creation story, as presented in Scripture, places man and woman as the crown of God's creation - God made them male and female (see: Genesis 5:2). Especially through the sacrament of holy matrimony, man and woman are called by God to live in complementarity in an indissoluble bond.

Remember that God did not only ask our first parents to multiply and fill the earth, He first of all blessed them. "So God created man in His own image; in the image of God He created them; male and female He created them. God blessed them and said to them, "Be fruitful and multiply, and fill the earth and subdue it" (Genesis 1:27-28). We are all sent into this world by God for different reasons. The most important reason as humans is to respect God's intention of creating us - male and female and be proud of who we are. If we are able to do that, He (God) will bless us even more than we can imagine. One thing we need to know is that, no matter how we turn the Scripture around, we cannot change the intention of our Creator and God. We are told in the Scripture that, "Heaven and earth will pass away, but my word will never pass away" (Matthew 24:35).

As we go about our duties this week, we are called by God to bear in mind that He is watching, and His intention for creating us in His image and likeness are very clear. Whatever we do that goes contrary to His intention cannot be justified; neither in this life nor in the life to come. May God give us the grace to accept His word and live according to His laws. Amen.
