Our parish assigned goal for this year is \$87,150.00, which is \$4,150.00 more than last year's. Thanks to your amazing generosity, we were able to exceed last year's goal by \$7,558.69.

Established over fifty years ago, the Diocesan Services Fund continues to help raise funds to provide support to over sixty crucial pastoral and educational programs and ministries in the archdiocese. This year's theme is an invitation to us to continue this amazing work of charity for the glory of God.

The funds realized through the DSF campaign benefit parishes in different ways. For example, it helps to provide ongoing formation to priests, deacons, and catechetical ministers. In addition, DSF helps to sustain ministries within the archdiocese that provide medical care to the uninsured, accompany families and married couples, and provide pastoral care to the sick, the elderly and the imprisoned.

So how is the DSF different from our ongoing parish Capital Campaign – One Faith, One Family? The DSF is an annual campaign organized by the archdiocese and is a way for all the parishes to come together and work as one in continuing the work of charity by supporting several pastoral and educational ministries within the archdiocese. Our Capital Campaign, on the other hand, is a parish effort, aimed at meeting the needs of Holy Family Parish, particularly to help raise funds to establish a Parish Life Center. We are currently working on Phase One of our One Faith, One Family Campaign.

Both efforts are aimed at continuing the work of evangelization. They both underscore the importance of working together as members of the Body of Christ. With the DSF, for instance, parishes are capable of achieving great results together that far exceed the scope and ability of any individual parish. Similarly, by giving to our parish Capital Campaign, we are able to accomplish great work, all to the glory of God! Thank you for your continued generous support of the work of evangelization.


