# Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

If, as they say, action speaks louder than words, then the actions of Jesus Christ, which we have just recounted through the solemn celebration of the Easter Triduum, have this clear message for all to hear: God so love the world, that He gave His only Begotten Son, Jesus Christ our Savior, who died to save us all! Christ is the face and realization of the infinite mercy of God.

Today, the Church celebrates *Divine Mercy Sunday*. Of course, God's mercy is in no way limited to a single celebration. However, on this Sunday, we are reminded in a special way of the unfathomable and infinite mercy of our God. Mercy is giving someone in love, what they do not deserve in justice! Saint Paul, in his Letter to the Romans, puts it well when he said that "God proves his love for us in that while we were still sinners Christ died for us. How much more then, since we are now justified by his blood, will we be saved through him from the wrath" (5:8-9).

Christ, through Saint Faustina, invites us to entrust ourselves to God's mercy. To all who approach God with great trust and expectant faith especially on this Divine Mercy Sunday, he has promised to lavish them with the extraordinary grace of "complete forgiveness of sins and [the] punishment" due to sins.

We can obtain this grace by receiving Holy Communion in a state of grace and by participating in the Divine Mercy devotion. We will be having the Divine Mercy prayers and devotion on Divine Mercy Sunday both in English (at the KC Hall, immediately following the 12:30 PM Mass at St. Mary's) and in Spanish (at St. Patrick, starting at 2PM). See the bulletin for more information.

God never tires of showering his love and mercy upon us. We simply need to trust and ask. Here is a simple formula to encourage us to always trust in God's mercy: the **A B C of Mercy** –

**A** – Ask for mercy;

**B** – Be merciful yourself; and

**C** – Completely trust.

And so we pray with humble faith: Eternal Father, we offer you the body and blood, soul and divinity of your dearly beloved Son, our Lord Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world. For the sake of his sorrowful passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world, amen!

We are one Holy Family Parish, united in the joy of the Holy Spirit and in charity, as missionary disciples, amen!

# Mensaje del Pastor

Amadísimos en Cristo:

Si, como dicen, la acción habla más que las palabras, entonces las acciones de Jesucristo, que acabamos de relatar a través de la solemne celebración del Triduo Pascual, tienen este claro mensaje para que todos lo escuchen: Dios ama tanto al mundo, que dio a su Hijo unigénito, Jesucristo nuestro Salvador, quien murió para salvarnos a todos! Hoy, la Iglesia celebra el **Domingo de la Divina Misericordia**. Por supuesto, la misericordia de Dios

celebración. Sin embargo, en este domingo se nos
recuerda de manera especial la insondable e infinita
misericordia de nuestro Dios. ¡Misericordia es dar a
alguien en amor, lo que no merece en justicia! San
Pablo, en su Carta a los Romanos, lo expresa bien
cuando dice que "Dios demuestra su amor por
nosotros en que, siendo aún pecadores, Cristo murió
por nosotros. ¿Cuánto más, siendo ahora justificados
en su sangre, seremos salvos por él de la ira" (5:8-9).

Cristo, a través de Santa Faustina, nos invita a encomendarnos a la misericordia de Dios. A todos los que se acercan a Dios con gran confianza y fe expectante, especialmente en este Domingo de la Divina Misericordia, les ha prometido colmarlos con la gracia extraordinaria del "perdón total de los pecados y [el] castigo" debido a los pecados.

Podemos obtener esta gracia recibiendo la Sagrada Comunión en estado de gracia y participando en la devoción a la Divina Misericordia. Tendremos las oraciones y la devoción a la Divina Misericordia el Domingo de la Divina Misericordia tanto en inglés (en el KC Hall, inmediatamente después de la misa de las 12:30 p. m. en St. Mary's) como en español (en St. Patrick, a partir de las 2 p. m.). Dios nunca se cansa de derramar su amor y misericordia sobre nosotros. Simplemente necesitamos confiar y pedir. He aquí una fórmula sencilla para animarnos a confiar siempre en la misericordia de Dios: el A B C de la Misericordia – A – Pide misericordia;

B – Ten misericordia de ti mismo; y

**C** – Confianza total.

Y así oramos con humilde fe: Padre Eterno, te ofrecemos el cuerpo y la sangre, el alma y la divinidad de tu amadísimo Hijo, nuestro Señor Jesucristo, en expiación por nuestros pecados y los del mundo entero. Por su dolorosa pasión, ten piedad de nosotros y del mundo entero, jamén!

Somos una Parroquia de la Sagrada Familia, unida en el gozo del Espíritu Santo y en la caridad, como discípulos misioneros, jamén!




