Christ is risen and Alleluia is our song! May the peace and joy of the Risen Lord always be with you, amen!

On Holy Saturday Night, we were blessed with welcoming new members to our faith family through the celebration of the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Holy Communion. We pray that they will continue to grow in faith and in their relationship with Jesus Christ, onto life everlasting. On page 5, I have shared a beautiful poem that was written by a parishioner, Ms. Anna Leigh Sargent; her poem is a succinct summary of the Easter gift we have received in Christ. Ms. Sargent was one of those who embraced the Catholic faith as an adult through the RCIA program about two years ago.

As we give thanks to God for the gift of motherhood next weekend, we are invited to team up with our local Pregnancy Help Center to provide support to mothers and families that are dealing with difficult pregnancies. We will be distributing baby bottles in support of the Center's **Baby Bottle Boomerang** annual fundraiser. Parishioners will be encouraged to take home the baby bottles, fill them up with loose change, and return the bottles on the weekend of **Fathers' Day** (June 18/19).

The Blessed Virgin Mary is the mother of all the redeemed! And May is the month of Mary. Let us honor her through the daily recitation of the Holy Rosary and earnestly implore her intercessions for our families and for the common good of all. We hope you can join us in celebrating **May Crowning** on any of the following days: 1. On **Friday, May 6th**, as part of our **Family First Fridays** gathering at St. Patrick, starting at 5:30PM; and, 2. during the **11AM Mass** on Sunday May 8th, as part of the celebration of **Mothers' Day**.

Finally, I am excited to share the good news that we are in the process of installing three new confessionals as well as relocating the tabernacle to the central position on the altar at St. Patrick's church. Two of the new confessionals will be located on either side of the sanctuary and the third will be in the Cry Room at the back of the church. We anticipate these updates to be completed within the next three months. The main cross has already been raised in preparation for the relocation of the tabernacle (see picture on page 5). With these changes, penitents will have privacy when they go to confession and the Tabernacle will take central place in the sanctuary!

The Veil Was Torn By Anna Leigh Sargent




