Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

Very close to my home parish in Lagos Nigeria – St. Joseph's Catholic Church – was a clinic. I cannot remember the name of the clinic but I do remember their logo, which read: "We Care, God Heals!" What a powerful reminder of the amazing collaboration between Divine and human elements when it comes to the care of the sick. Is it any wonder then that those who work in the medical industry are also commonly referred to as heath *care* givers!

Perhaps, one clear manifestation of this collaboration is seen when priests are called to the bedside of those who are sick, to provide them with pastoral consolation, especially through the sacraments of confession and the anointing of the sick. The priest, human, in those moments, serves as God's agent of healing. Through the pastoral ministry of the sick, care is given and healing granted in accordance to God's healing graces.

Many priests, ordained ministers and other pastoral associates continue to work as chaplains in hospitals and healthcare facilities throughout the world. Their work, however important, only serves to complement the immense care that is being provided by healthcare providers. These healthcare workers do not always get due recognition and appreciation for the work they do. They were on the forefront in the global response to the COVID-19 Pandemic, and many of them paid the ultimate price.

This weekend, we want to acknowledge and pray for them at the 7:30AM Mass at Sacred Heart; all healthcare providers and their families are invited to attend this Mass. We invite all parishioners to offer special prayers for them as well.

As we pray for our healthcare providers this weekend, let us remember to entrust them to the maternal care of the Blessed Virgin Mary, especially in this month of May which is dedicated to her honor. Also, we would like to invite everyone to a Public Rosary Recitation on Saturday, May 21st, at 12:00 Noon, at St. Mary's Cathedral-Basilica. We will gather in front of the basilica; please park your vehicles in the parking lot or on the street.

Note that from Monday, May 23rd to Friday, May 27th, all priests in the archdiocese will be attending the Biennial Convocation of Priests. As such we will only have the 7AM Mass on those days; this will take place at St. Mary's Cathedral Basilica (and NOT at the chapel). Exposition/Adoration of the Eucharist will take place as usual in the chapel.

We are one Holy Family Parish, united in the joy of the Holy Spirit and in charity, as missionary disciples, amen!

Nos reuniremos frente a la basílica; estacione sus vehículos en el estacionamiento o en la calle.




WE ARE HIS WITNESSES

God the Father raised Jesus from the dead and for many days he was seen by his apostles and friends, and all those who accompanied him from Galilee to Jerusalem. They are his witnesses and we believe everything they said and have written down. They are our firsthand witnesses because they saw him, touched him, spoke with him, walked many miles with him, and even ate and drank with him throughout his earthly ministry. Some of his apostles and friends were there with him at the foot of the cross. Remember John the Evangelist, whom he addressed from the cross? "Woman, behold your son. Then to the disciple, Jesus said, behold your mother" (see John 19:26-27).

Saint Peter with all confidence in Acts 10:39-43 says, we are witnesses of all that Jesus did both in the country of the Jews and in Jerusalem; we ate and drank with him after he rose from the dead. He commissioned us to preach to the people and testify that he is the one appointed by God as judge of the living and the dead. To him all the prophets bear witness that everyone who believes in him, will receive forgiveness of sins through his name. This experience for Saint Peter, was a life-changing one and nothing could change his mind from what he had seen and come to believe.

We too are Jesus' witnesses, and as Catholics, we only proclaim what we believe. So, we must share with God's people what we believe and have experienced as followers of the risen Lord.

May the Holy Spirit of God continue to work through us, that we may courageously bear witness to our friends, brothers, and sisters of our experience about the mercy and love of God, now and always. Amen.






