## Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

Very close to my home parish in Lagos Nigeria – St. Joseph's Catholic Church – was a clinic. I cannot remember the name of the clinic but I do remember their logo, which read: *"We Care, God Heals!"* What a powerful reminder of the amazing collaboration between Divine and human elements when it comes to the care of the sick. Is it any wonder then that those who work in the medical industry are also commonly referred to as health **care** givers!

Perhaps, one clear manifestation of this collaboration is seen when priests are called to the bedside of those who are sick, to provide them with pastoral consolation, especially through the sacraments of confession and the anointing of the sick. The priest, human, in those moments, serves as God's agent of healing. Through the pastoral ministry of the sick, care is given and healing granted in accordance to God's healing graces.

Many priests, ordained ministers and other pastoral associates continue to work as chaplains in hospitals and healthcare facilities throughout the world. Their work, however important, only serves to complement the immense care that is being provided by healthcare providers. These healthcare workers do not always get due recognition and appreciation for the work they do. They were on the forefront in the global response to the COVID-19 Pandemic, and many of them paid the ultimate price.

This weekend, we want to acknowledge and pray for them at the 7:30AM Mass at Sacred Heart; all healthcare providers and their families are invited to attend this Mass. We invite all parishioners to offer special prayers for them as well.

As we pray for our healthcare providers this weekend, let us remember to entrust them to the maternal care of the Blessed Virgin Mary, especially in this month of May which is dedicated to her honor. Also, we would like to invite everyone to a **Public Rosary Recitation on Saturday, May 21st, at 12:00 Noon, at St. Mary's Cathedral-Basilica**. We will gather in front of the basilica; please park your vehicles in the parking lot or on the street.

Note that from Monday, **May 23rd to Friday, May 27th, all priests in the archdiocese will be attending the Biennial Convocation of Priests**. As such we will only have the 7AM Mass on those days; this will take place at St. Mary's Cathedral Basilica (and NOT at the chapel). Exposition/Adoration of the Eucharist will take place as usual in the chapel.

We are one **Holy Family Parish, united in the joy of the Holy Spirit and in charity, as missionary disciples, amen!**

No recuerdo el nombre de la clínica, pero sí recuerdo su logotipo, que decía: *"¡Nos importa, Dios sana!"*. Qué poderoso recordatorio de la asombrosa colaboración entre los elementos divinos y humanos cuando se trata del cuidado de los enfermos. ¿Es de extrañar entonces que aquellos que trabajan en la industria médica también sean comúnmente conocidos como *cuidadores* de la salud?

Quizás, una clara manifestación de esta colaboración se ve cuando los sacerdotes son llamados al lado de la cama de los enfermos, para brindarles el consuelo pastoral, especialmente a través de los sacramentos de la confesión y la unción de los enfermos. El sacerdote, humano, en esos momentos, sirve como agente de sanación de Dios. A través del ministerio pastoral de los enfermos, se brinda atención y curación de acuerdo con las gracias curativas de Dios.

Muchos sacerdotes, ministros ordenados y otros asociados pastorales continúan trabajando como capellanes en hospitales y centros de salud en todo el mundo. Su trabajo, por importante que sea, solo sirve para complementar la inmensa atención que brindan los proveedores de atención médica. Estos trabajadores de la salud no siempre obtienen el debido reconocimiento y aprecio por el trabajo que realizan. Estuvieron a la vanguardia en la respuesta global a la pandemia de COVID-19, y muchos de ellos pagaron el precio final.

Este fin de semana, queremos reconocer y orar por ellos en la Misa de las 7:30 AM en el Sagrado Corazón; todos los proveedores de atención médica y sus familias están invitados a asistir a esta Misa. Invitamos a todos los feligreses a ofrecer oraciones especiales por ellos también.

Mientras oramos por nuestros proveedores de atención médica este fin de semana, recordemos encomendarlos al cuidado maternal de la Santísima Virgen María, especialmente en este mes de mayo dedicado a su honor. Además, nos gustaría invitar a todos a un **rezo público del Rosario el sábado 21 de mayo a las 12:00 del mediodía en la Catedral-Basilica de Santa María**. Nos reuniremos frente a la basílica; estacione sus vehículos en el estacionamiento o en la calle.

Tenga en cuenta que desde el lunes **23 de mayo hasta el viernes 27 de mayo, todos los sacerdotes de la arquidiócesis asistirán a la Convocatoria Bial de Sacerdotes**. Como tal, solo tendremos la misa de las 7 a.m. en esos días; esto tendrá lugar en la Catedral Basílica de Santa María (y NO en la capilla). La Exposición/Adoración de la Eucaristía tendrá lugar como de costumbre en la capilla.

Somos una **Parroquia de la Sagrada Familia, unida en el gozo del Espíritu Santo y en la caridad, como discípulos misioneros, ¡amén!**




### WE ARE HIS WITNESSES
