#### Dearly Beloved in Christ:

Happy feast day of the **Ascension of our Lord Jesus Christ!** Perhaps some of you, especially older Catholics, might be wondering why this feast is not taking place on a Thursday. Christ's ascension took place forty days after his resurrection, which is usually on a Thursday. So why are we celebrating it on a Sunday?

Canon 1246, §2 of the **Code of Canon Law** gives the right to a conference of bishops to "abolish certain days of obligation or **transfer them to a Sunday with prior approval of the Apostolic See".** In light of this provision, the National Conference of Catholic Bishops of the United States in 1999, decided that each Ecclesiastical province in the United States may transfer the Solemnity of the Ascension of Our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ from Thursday of the Sixth Week of Easter to the Seventh Sunday of Easter. This is why we celebrate this feast on Sunday.

Since it is optional for certain feasts to be transferred to a Sunday in order to provide the opportunity for more of the Faithful to participate in it, the feast of the Ascension was moved by the Conference of Bishops for our Province from Thursday to Sunday. Other examples of movable feasts are the Feast of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph; and the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord. In many regions of the world however, the feast of the Ascension of the Lord is still celebrated on a Thursday.

Christ's ascension into heaven vindicates Him as the Son of God who does his Father's will; confirms His message of salvation as altogether reliable; and invites us to be His faithful witnesses to the ends of the earth.

By ascending, Christ did not abandon us; rather, he has gone before us so that where He, the Master and Leader has gone, we too may follow. This truth is expressed beautifully in the opening prayer for the Mass today: "[the] Ascension of Christ is our exaltation, and, where the Head has gone before in glory, the Body is called to follow in hope". May we always keep our eyes on Jesus and on the things of heaven, amen!

Remember that our Holy Family Catholic school is currently enrolling students for the 2022-20232 academic school year. Parents, grandparents and guardians, we are inviting you to partner with us to ensure that your children receive a solid Catholic foundation in their lives.

We are one Holy Family Parish, united in the joy of the Holy Spirit and in charity, as missionary disciples, amen!

## Mensaje del Pastor

Amadísimos en Cristo:

¡Feliz fiesta de la **Ascensión de Nuestro Señor Jesucristo!** Quizás algunos de ustedes, especialmente los católicos mayores, se pregunten por qué esta fiesta no se lleva a cabo un jueves. La ascensión de Cristo tuvo lugar cuarenta días después de su resurrección, que suele ser un jueves. Entonces, ¿por qué lo celebramos en domingo?

El canon 1246, §2 del **Código de Derecho Canónico** otorga a una conferencia de obispos el derecho de "suprimir ciertos días de precepto o **trasladarlos al domingo con la aprobación previa de la Sede Apostólica**". A la luz de esta disposición, la Conferencia Nacional de Obispos Católicos de los Estados Unidos en 1999, decidió que cada provincia eclesiástica de los Estados Unidos puede transferir la Solemnidad de la Ascensión de Nuestro Señor y Salvador Jesucristo del jueves de la Sexta Semana de Pascua al Séptimo Domingo de Pascua. Por eso celebramos esta fiesta el domingo.

Dado que es opcional que ciertas fiestas se transfieran a un domingo para brindar la oportunidad de que más fieles participen en ellas, la fiesta de la Ascensión fue trasladada por la Conferencia de Obispos de nuestra Provincia del jueves al domingo. Otros ejemplos de fiestas móviles son la Fiesta de la Sagrada Familia de Jesús, María y José; y la Fiesta del Bautismo del Señor. Sin embargo, en muchas regiones del mundo, la fiesta de la Ascensión del Señor todavía se celebra un jueves.

La ascensión de Cristo al cielo lo reivindica como Hijo de Dios que hace la voluntad de su Padre; confirma Su mensaje de salvación como totalmente confiable; y nos invita a ser sus fieles testigos hasta los confines de la tierra.

Al ascender, Cristo no nos abandonó; antes bien, ha ido delante de nosotros para que adonde ha ido Él, el Maestro y Caudillo, nosotros también lo sigamos. Esta verdad se expresa bellamente en la oración de apertura de la Misa de hoy: "[la] Ascensión de Cristo es nuestra exaltación, y donde la Cabeza ha ido antes en la gloria, el Cuerpo está llamado a seguirla en la esperanza". ¡Que siempre tengamos la mirada puesta en Jesús y en las cosas del cielo, amén!

Recuerde que nuestra escuela católica Holy Family actualmente está inscribiendo estudiantes para el año escolar académico 2022-20232. Padres, abuelos y tutores, los invitamos a asociarse con nosotros para garantizar que sus hijos reciban una base católica sólida en sus vidas.

Somos una Parroquia de la Sagrada Familia, unida en el gozo del Espíritu Santo y en la caridad, como discípulos misioneros, jamén!



## **ASCENSION OF THE LORD**

Dear Lord, we thank you for coming and for dying for our sake. We thank you for the time you spent making yourself known to your disciples after your resurrection. It has been a wonderful time listening to you speak about the Father and the Paraclete which the Father will send to us. Thank you for

the assurance that you will not leave us orphans. Since it is not our place to know the times or the seasons that God the Father has established by his authority, we are relying on your promise of the Holy Spirit, the Paraclete which you will send to us to empower us and make us true witnesses of all that you have spoken to us through your apostles.

The scripture says, as they watched, he was lifted up and a cloud took him from their sight. While they were still looking intently at the sky as Christ was going, suddenly two men in white garments (angels) reminded them that the same Jesus they saw going up to heaven, will come back the same way he was taken up (see Acts 1:6-11).

So my dear friends, we have to do our part as long as the sun is still shining. We have to speak to the people of God about the Messiah who has gone before us to prepare a place for us, so that when at last our own part of the mission of Christ is done, we can like Saint Paul proudly say, "I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith (1 Timothy 4:7 -8). While we are still hoping to join the risen Christ someday, let us continue with his mission, "Go into the whole world and proclaim the gospel to all nations" (Mark 16:15). May the Holy Spirit, The great Paraclete, continue to inspire us to do the will of the Father. Amen.




## Baby Bottle Boomerang
