

## Message from the Pastor

#### Dearly Beloved in Christ:

As we celebrate the Feast of **Pentecost**, the Church invites us to pray: "Lord, send out your Spirit, and renew the face of the earth". Our world cries and yearns desperately for renewal! In a world that is grossly polluted with different forms and manifestations of the workings of death, we need a renewal! And this is what the Holy Spirit gives – an abundance of life, Divine life, that is!

At Pentecost, the promise of Jesus Christ to ask the Heavenly Father to send us *Another Advocate* is fulfilled (see: **John 14:16**). The Greek word that is often translated as "comforter", "Counsellor", and sometimes, "Helper", is *parakletos*. The word means "one called to the side of another" for the purpose of counseling and providing support. Thus, regarding the Holy Spirit, Christ tells us that the "Advocate, the holy Spirit that the Father will send in my name—he will teach you everything and remind you of all that I told you" (John 14:26).

The Holy Spirit, the Paraclete, is the One who answers the call! St. Paul tells us that "the Spirit too comes to the aid of our weakness; for we do not know how to pray as we ought, but the Spirit itself intercedes with inexpressible groanings. And the one who searches hearts knows what is the intention of the Spirit, because it intercedes for the holy ones according to God's will" (Romans 8:26-27; emphasis added). We see this manifested particularly on the day of Pentecost. For on that day, as the disciples were gathered in prayer, they were suddenly filled with the presence and power of the Holy Spirit. Aided by the Spirit, they went out to give witness to the Gospel!

And the Spirit continues to answer our call, always coming to our aid. At the celebration of the Holy Eucharist for instance, the priest prays asking God to "Make holy, therefore, these gifts, we pray, by **sending down your Spirit upon them** like the dewfall, so that they may become for us the Body and Blood of our Lord Jesus Christ" (**Eucharistic Prayer II**). By the aid of the Holy Spirit, ordinary bread and wine is transformed into the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of our Lord Jesus Christ!

The Spirit truly comes to our aid. Let us make it a habit of calling on the Holy Spirit to aid us. Let us ask the Spirit for a renewal of our lives, our families, communities, our nation, and our world. *Come, Holy Spirit, come! Come to our aid and fill us with the fire of your love. Come Advocate; come to our aid we pray, amen!* 

We are one Holy Family Parish, united in the joy of the Holy Spirit and in charity, as missionary disciples, amen!

## Mensaje del Pastor

Amadísimos en Cristo:

Al celebrar la fiesta de **Pentecostés**, la Iglesia nos invita a rezar: "Señor, envía tu Espíritu y renueva la faz de la tierra". ¡Nuestro mundo llora y anhela desesperadamente una renovación! En un mundo que está groseramente contaminado con diferentes formas y manifestaciones del funcionamiento de la muerte, ¡necesitamos una renovación! Y esto es lo que da el Espíritu Santo: ¡abundancia de vida, vida divina, eso es!

En Pentecostés se cumple la promesa de Jesucristo de pedirle al Padre Celestial que nos envíe Otro Abogado (ver: **Juan 14:16**). La palabra griega que a menudo se traduce como "consolador", "Consejero" y, a veces, "Ayudador", es **parakletos.** La palabra significa "uno llamado al lado de otro" con el propósito de aconsejar y brindar apoyo. Así, respecto al Espíritu Santo, Cristo nos dice que el "Abogado, el Espíritu Santo que el Padre enviará en mi nombre, él os enseñará todo y os recordará todo lo que os he dicho" (**Juan 14:26**).

¡El Espíritu Santo, el Paráclito, es el que responde a la llamada! San Pablo nos dice que "también el Espíritu viene en ayuda de nuestra debilidad; porque no sabemos orar como conviene, pero el Espíritu mismo intercede con gemidos inefables. Y el que escudriña los corazones sabe cuál es el propósito del Espíritu, porque conforme a la voluntad de Dios intercede por los santos" (Romanos 8:26-27; cursiva agregada). Vemos esto manifestado particularmente en el día de Pentecostés. Porque ese día, mientras los discípulos estaban reunidos en oración, de repente fueron llenos de la presencia y el poder del Espíritu Santo. ¡Ayudados por el Espíritu, salieron a dar testimonio del Evangelio! Y el Espíritu sigue respondiendo a nuestra llamada, siempre acudiendo en nuestra ayuda. En la celebración de la Sagrada Eucaristía, por ejemplo, el sacerdote ora pidiendo a Dios que "haga santos, por lo tanto, estos dones, te rogamos, enviando tu Espíritu sobre ellos como gotas de rocío, para que se conviertan para nosotros en el Cuerpo y la Sangre. de nuestro Señor Jesucristo" (Plegaria Eucarística II). ¡Con la ayuda del Espíritu Santo, el pan y el vino comunes se transforman en el Cuerpo y la Sangre, el Alma y la Divinidad de nuestro Señor Jesucristo!

El Espíritu verdaderamente viene en nuestra ayuda. Acostumbrémonos a invocar al Espíritu Santo para que nos ayude. Pidamos al Espíritu una renovación de nuestras vidas, nuestras familias, comunidades, nuestra nación y nuestro mundo. ¡Ven, Espíritu Santo, ven! Ven en nuestra ayuda y llénanos con el fuego de tu amor. Ven Abogado; ven en nuestra ayuda te rogamos, amén!

Somos una Parroquia de la Sagrada Familia, unida en el gozo del Espíritu Santo y en la caridad, como discípulos misioneros, jamén!
