

Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

Happy Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity! This feast is the foundation of our faith; indeed, it is the foundation of all! Regarding the Holy Trinity, St. Athanasius powerfully remarked that "upon this faith [in the Holy Trinity] the church is built, and if anyone were to lapse from it, he would no longer be a Christian either in fact or in name." Each time, as Catholics, we make the sign of the cross, we are professing our faith in the mystery of the Holy Trinity.

We profess faith in God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Spirit. The three Divine Persons are equally God yet distinct. St. Athanasius continues: "We acknowledge the Trinity, holy and perfect, to consist of the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. In this Trinity there is no intrusion of any alien element or of anything from outside, nor is the Trinity a blend of creative and created being. It is a wholly creative and energizing reality, self-consistent and undivided in its active power, for the Father makes all things through the Word and in the Holy Spirit, and in this way the unity of the holy Trinity is preserved. Accordingly, in the Church, one God is preached, one God who is above all things and through all things and in all things. God is above all things as Father, for he is principle and source; he is through all things through the Word; and he is in all things in the Holy Spirit."

The Theological maxim, lex orandi, lex credendi, loosely translates as: "the law of praying is the law of believing". Simply put, it means as Catholics, we pray what we believe and we believe what we pray. The Creed is a perfect example of this. Each time we pray the creed at Mass, we are at the same time professing the core tenets of our Catholic faith. Our prayer therefore, both informs as well as expresses our beliefs. And so, when the priest at the start of Mass greets the congregation saying, The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ and the love of God and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you all, he is professing the Holy Trinity and asking the blessings of the Divine Persons on all. "For grace and the gift of the Trinity are given by the Father through the Son in the Holy Spirit. Just as grace is given from the Father through the Son, so there could be no communication of the gift to us except in the Holy Spirit. But when we share in the Spirit, we possess the love of the Father, the grace of the Son and the fellowship of the Spirit himself", remarks St. Athanasius.

And may God Almighty bless you, + the Father, and the Son, and the Holy Spirit. Amen!

We are one Holy Family Parish, united in the joy of the Holy Spirit and in charity, as missionary disciples, amen!

Mensaje del Pastor

Amadísimos en Cristo:

¡Feliz Solemnidad de la Santísima Trinidad! Esta fiesta es el fundamento de nuestra fe; de hecho, ¡es el fundamento de todo! Con respecto a la Santísima Trinidad, San Atanasio señaló poderosamente que "sobre esta fe [en la Santísima Trinidad] se edifica la iglesia, y si alguien se apartara de ella, ya no sería cristiano ni de hecho ni de nombre". Cada vez que, como católicos, hacemos la señal de la cruz, estamos profesando nuestra fe en el misterio de la Santísima Trinidad.

Profesamos la fe en Dios Padre, Dios Hijo y Dios Espíritu Santo. Las tres Personas Divinas son igualmente Dios pero distintas. San Atanasio continúa: "Reconocemos que la Trinidad, santa y perfecta, consiste en el Padre, el Hijo y el Espíritu Santo. En esta Trinidad no hay intrusión de ningún elemento extraño o de nada del exterior, ni es la Trinidad una mezcla de ser creativo y creado. Es una realidad enteramente creadora y vigorizante, autoconsistente e indivisa en su poder activo, porque el Padre hace todas las cosas por la Palabra y en el Espíritu Santo, y así se conserva la unidad de la Santísima Trinidad. En consecuencia, en la Iglesia se predica un solo Dios, un solo Dios que está sobre todas las cosas y por todas las cosas y en todas las cosas. Dios está sobre todas las cosas como Padre, porque es principio y fuente; él es a través de todas las cosas a través de la Palabra; y él está en todas las cosas en el Espíritu Santo."

La máxima teológica, lex orandi, lex credendi, se traduce vagamente como: "la ley de orar es la ley de creer". En pocas palabras, significa que, como católicos, rezamos lo que creemos y creemos lo que rezamos. El Credo es un ejemplo perfecto de esto. Cada vez que rezamos el credo en la Misa, al mismo tiempo estamos profesando los principios básicos de nuestra fe católica. Nuestra oración, por lo tanto, tanto informa como expresa nuestras creencias. Y así, cuando el sacerdote al comienzo de la Misa saluda a la congregación diciendo: La gracia de nuestro Señor Jesucristo y el amor de Dios y la comunión del Espíritu Santo sean con todos vosotros, está profesando la Santísima Trinidad y pidiendo las bendiciones de las Personas Divinas sobre todos. "Porque la gracia y el don de la Trinidad son dados por el Padre por medio del Hijo en el Espíritu Santo. Así como la gracia es dada por el Padre a través del Hijo, así no podría haber comunicación del don a nosotros excepto en el Espíritu Santo. Pero cuando participamos del Espíritu, poseemos el amor del Padre, la gracia del Hijo y la comunión del mismo Espíritu", comenta San Atanasio.

Y que Dios Todopoderoso los bendiga, + el Padre, y el Hijo, y el Espíritu Santo. ¡Amén!

Somos una Parroquia de la Sagrada Familia, unida en el gozo del Espíritu Santo y en la caridad, como discípulos misioneros, jamén!

The Bereavement Committee is in need of volunteers. The Bereavement Committee reaches out to families who have suffered the loss of a loved one through death.


Committee members help with the reception, usually held in the parish auditorium, that often follows a funeral Mass or service.


