The Bereavement Committee is in need of volunteers. The Bereavement Committee reaches out to families who have suffered the loss of a loved one through death.


Committee members help with the reception, usually held in the parish auditorium, that often follows a funeral Mass or service.





Did you have some singing experience in grade school or high school, college?


(Clearly, you need to be able to "carry a tune".)




