Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

This weekend, the archdiocese is encouraging all parishes to support the **Society of St. Vincent de Paul's Annual Black Bag Collection**. This collection is for the archdiocesan St. Vincent de Paul Council, which is different from our local parish St. Vincent de Paul's periodic Black Bag collections. In other words, the Black Bag Collection for this weekend goes to the general organizing body of the society within our archdiocese.

The good news is that both our local parish group and the general archdiocesan Council work together to continue the work of spreading Christ's love to our brothers and sisters in need. Last year alone, the archdiocesan Council provided assistance to over **52,000** in our archdiocese. **The Society distributed \$8 million dollars in food assistance, helped over 11,000 families with \$3.7 million in financial assistance, and provided \$800,000 in direct aid to families affected by the pandemic.**

This great work will not be possible without the generosity of parishioners like you throughout the archdiocese; for this we say, "thank you!" And we would like to invite you to continue your generous support of the work of charity. Parishioners who receive the regular offering envelopes would have noticed one for this weekend's annual St. Vincent de Paul's Black Bag Collection. For others, you may mail in your donations to the parish office or give online by going to the parish's website - www.holyfamilygb.com.

Pope Francis' encouraging words when it comes to the work of charity are worth mentioning here: "The measure of the greatness of a Society is found in the way it treats those most in need, those who have nothing apart from their poverty". Through charity, we continue to create a better society for all.

Our God is a generous giver, and as He blesses us He wants us to be mindful of our brothers and sisters in need. 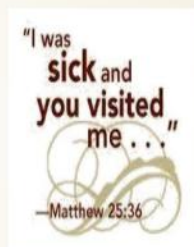

Since you O Lord know my heart and everything I am made of, please help me in my daily struggles to obey your law which refreshes my poor soul. Your words Lord, are the lamp for my steps toward you. They give me insight and wisdom to live a good christian life and to be truly your follower. You are just in all your ways and a merciful Father beyond compare. In your mercy, please revive my drooping spirit; make it obey you in all sincerity, for you search and know my heart and how much love it has for you, my Creator and my God.

Lord, please remove from me anything that is against your law and fill me with everything that is yours. Mold me into what you created me for and make me into what you want me to be, for your greater honor and glory. Amen.

I love you Lord; you are the light of my soul.

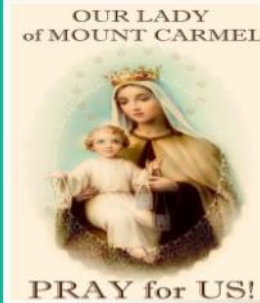

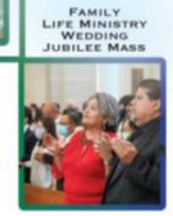

What is "Betania XVII"? Betania XVII is one of 21 global lay communities which seek to promote devotion to Our Lady, Virgin and Mother, Reconciler of All Peoples and Nations, who appeared to 150+ people in 1987, holding her Son at a small farm called "Betania(Bethany)" about two hours outside of Caracas, Venezuela. The local Bishop has approved of these apparitions, finding them to be "worthy of belief."

The primary seer, Servant of God Maria Esperanza de Bianchini was a spiritual daughter of St. Padre Pio and manifested many of the mystical gifts he expressed. Often she sends a yellow butterfly as a sign of her intercessory presence. Maria Esperanza, although chiefly a wife and mother of seven, was called to speak in many countries around the world.

Recently, the Betania Foundation (consisting of the 21 global Betania communities) was designated a Public Association of the Faithful by the Cardinal of Caracas. This title denotes a certain approval and official recognition by the Church of our humble work of serving Jesus and His Mother.
