#### Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

Early in February, all parishes in the archdiocese launched the annual **Diocesan Services Funds**. This annual campaign is our collective way of responding to the invitation of Jesus Christ to welcome and recognize him in our brothers and sisters in need. And we are called to do all of this, *All for the Glory of God*, which aptly is the theme for this year's DSF campaign.

The DSF Campaign continues this week in parishes throughout the arch-diocese with the **third Commitment Weekend** (the first two were in February and May respectively). The purpose of the commitment weekend is twofold: first, is to thank all parishioners who have generously contributed to the DSF. Currently, we have raised over \$70,000.00, which is about 80% of our allotted parish goal of \$87,150. This amount has been donated generously, as at the time of writing, by 255 participants from our parish. These participants include both individuals and registered families as well.

And this brings me to the second purpose for these commitment weekends namely, to invite all parishioners to prayerfully consider making a donation to the DSF. In our parish, we have a little over 2,300 registered parishioners/individuals. While all of us cannot give at the same level, we can all sacrificially contribute according to our abilities to help sustain the various social, educational and pastoral ministries that are supported by the DSF. We thank you as you prayerfully consider donating to this year's DSF.

Regarding the DSF, I would like to end on a note of gratitude. Ever since my resumption here at Holy Family, I have been encouraged by your great generosity as you share your **time**, **talent and treasure** to help promote the Gospel message here at our parish and beyond. Additionally, we have always made our DSF goal. The good news is that the parish receives as rebate 50% of the total amount we raise over our assigned parish goal.

On a different note, I would like to share the exciting news about a new parish ministry that will be starting soon, called - Holy Family Parish Widows' Network (HFPWN). This ministry will provide a platform for widows to pray, network, encourage and mutually support one another. We have scheduled a Meet and Greet for this group on Sunday, August 14th at St. Mary's Basilica at 6PM. See page 11 for more information.

A principios de febrero, todas las parroquias de la arquidiócesis lanzaron los **Fondos de Servicios Diocesanos anuales**. Esta campaña anual es nuestra forma colectiva de responder a la invitación de Jesucristo de acogerlo y reconocerlo en nuestros hermanos y hermanas necesitados. Y estamos llamados a hacer todo esto, *Todo para la Gloria de Dios*, que acertadamente es el tema de la campaña DSF de este año.

La Campaña DSF continúa esta semana en las parroquias de la arquidiócesis con el **tercer Fin de Semana de Compromiso** (los dos primeros fueron en febrero y mayo respectivamente). El propósito del fin de semana de compromiso es doble: primero, es agradecer a todos los feligreses que han contribuido generosamente al DSF. Actualmente, hemos recaudado más de \$70,000.00, que es aproximadamente el 80% de nuestra meta parroquial asignada de \$87,150. Esta cantidad ha sido donada generosamente, al momento de escribir este artículo, por 255 participantes de nuestra parroquia. Estos participantes incluyen tanto individuos como familias registradas también.

Y esto me lleva al segundo propósito de estos fines de semana de compromiso, a saber, invitar a todos los feligreses a considerar en oración hacer una donación al DSF. En nuestra parroquia tenemos un poco más de 2,300 feligreses/individuos registrados. Si bien no todos podemos dar al mismo nivel, todos podemos contribuir con sacrificio de acuerdo con nuestras habilidades para ayudar a sostener los diversos ministerios sociales, educativos y pastorales que son apoyados por el DSF. Le agradecemos que considere en oración donar al DSF de este año.

En cuanto al DSF, me gustaría terminar con una nota de agradecimiento. Desde mi regreso aquí en Holy Family, me ha alentado su gran generosidad al compartir su **tiempo, talento y tesoro** para ayudar a promover el mensaje del Evangelio aquí en nuestra parroquia y más allá. Además, siempre hemos logrado nuestro objetivo DSF. La buena noticia es que la parroquia recibe como reembolso el 50% del monto total que recaudamos sobre nuestra meta parroquial asignada.

En una nota diferente, me gustaría compartir las emocionantes noticias sobre un nuevo ministerio parroquial que comenzará pronto, llamado Red de Viudas de la Parroquia de la Sagrada Familia (HFPWN). Este ministerio proporcionará una plataforma para que las viudas oren, trabajen en red, se animen y se apoyen mutuamente. Hemos programado un Meet and Greet para este grupo el domingo 14 de agosto en la Basílica de Santa María a las 6 p.m. Consulte la página 11 para obtener más información.

The Bereavement Committee is in need of volunteers. The Bereavement Committee reaches out to families who have suffered the loss of a loved one through death.


Committee members help with the reception, usually held in the parish auditorium, that often follows a funeral Mass or service.





RICA y la Iniciación Cristiana de Niños

que han alcanzado la edad catequética. (7 años o más)

Este es un programa (proceso) de dos años para niños que no fueron bautizados de infantes, que han alcanzado la edad de la razón, están en edad de catequesis y que participarán en el Rito de Iniciación Cristiana en la Vigilia Pascual.

Los niños asistirán a clases semanales apropiadas para su edad y los padres asistirán a las reuniones de preparación sacramental periódicamente según sea necesario. Los candidatos celebrarán los Sacramentos de Iniciación (Bautismo, Confirmación y Eucaristía) en la vigilia pascual de su segundo año.

El primer año (etapa) del viaje de fe se llama la indagación. Las clases se centran en Dios y en el amor de Dios. Cubren preguntas básicas en las áreas de la creencia católica, la misa, la Biblia, los santos, la oración y las prácticas. Este es un momento para consultas para aprender las formas en que los católicos adoran juntos y cómo dan vida a su fe cristiana. Esta etapa culmina con el compromiso de ingresar al catecumenado, para prepararse para ingresar como miembro pleno de la Iglesia Católica.

El segundo año (etapa) de clases enfatiza la relación del niño con Dios y sus familias dentro del cuerpo de Cristo, la Iglesia. El proceso continuará con las etapas de Catecumenado, Cuaresma y Mistagogía. Un padrino acompaña al niño en su viaje. Todos los patrocinadores deben cumplir con los requisitos diocesanos.

La inscripción para el primer año (etapa) requiere completar el formulario de inscripción La inscripción para el segundo año requiere llenar los formularios de inscripción y traer una copia del acta de nacimiento de su hijo.

Durante los dos años, se llevan a cabo sesiones especiales para ayudar a los niños, las familias, los patrocinadores a prepararse para la celebración de los Sacramentos de iniciación, y se requiere que los padres asistan a la sesión y retiro obligatorio para padres.

La celebración de los Sacramentos de iniciación tiene lugar durante la Vigilia Pascual del segundo año. Los Candidatos luego comienzan un período de reflexión sobre el proceso de iniciación llamado mistagogia donde reflexionan sobre los sacramentos celebrados y continúan creciendo en su fe.
