## Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

I am very delighted to announce that starting in August, we will be having the First Saturday Mass Devotions here in our parish! Hence, the first Mass will be on Saturday, August 6th at 8am at St. Mary's Cathedral-Basilica. How fitting it is that we will be gathering, henceforth, on the first Saturdays of each month, in the mother Church of Texas, heeding the call of our Blessed Mother to offer prayers and make reparations for sins!

The Five First Saturdays or more aptly, the Five First Saturdays Devotion of Reparation to the Immaculate Heart of the Blessed Virgin, is our response in love to the invitation of the Blessed Virgin Mary and of Our Lord, given during the apparitions at Fatima and affirmed thereafter by our Lord and the Blessed Virgin Mary. This devotion consists in going to Confession, receiving Holy Communion, reciting five decades of the Rosary and meditating for 15 minutes the mysteries of the Rosary on the first Saturday of five consecutive months.

It is important to state that these conditions are to be carried out with the *intention of making reparation to the Immaculate Heart of Mary*. With regards to going to confession, one may do so during the eight days preceding or following the first Saturday of each month, provided that Holy Communion be received in the state of grace. Even one's monthly confession would still suffice, as long as one remembers to form the intention of making reparation to the Immaculate Heart of Mary.

Why five Saturdays, some may wonder? Our Lord Jesus Christ Himself would answer this question when, during his apparition to Sr. Lucia on May 29, 1930 explained that this is to make apparitions for five kinds of blasphemies and offenses against the Immaculate Heart of Mary namely: blasphemies against her Immaculate Conception, against her perpetual virginity, against the divine and spiritual maternity of Mary, blasphemies involving the rejection and dishonoring of her images, and the neglect of implanting in the hearts of children a knowledge and love of this Immaculate Mother.

To those who devoutly fulfill the Five First Saturday devotion, Our Lady has promised unfailingly to assist them with all the graces necessary for the salvation of their souls at their hour of death. Our Lady also implores us to offer this devotion for the salvation of sinners and for peace in the world.

We are one Holy Family Parish, united in the joy of the Holy Spirit and in charity, as missionary disciples, amen!

## Mensaje del Pastor

Amadísimos en Cristo:

¡Estoy muy complacido de anunciar que a partir de agosto tendremos las devociones de la misa del primer sábado aquí en nuestra parroquia! Por lo tanto, la primera misa será el sábado 6 de agosto a las 8 am en la Catedral-Basílica de Santa María. ¡Qué apropiado es que nos reunamos, de ahora en adelante, los primeros sábados de cada mes, en la Iglesia madre de Texas, atendiendo el llamado de nuestra Santísima Madre para ofrecer oraciones y reparar los pecados!

Los Cinco Primeros Sábados o más acertadamente, la Devoción de Reparación de los Cinco Primeros Sábados al Inmaculado Corazón de la Santísima Virgen, es nuestra respuesta de amor a la invitación de la Santísima Virgen María y de Nuestro Señor, dada durante las apariciones en Fátima y afirmada después por nuestro Señor y la Santísima Virgen María. Esta devoción consiste en confesarse, comulgar, rezar cinco decenas del Rosario y meditar durante 15 minutos los misterios del Rosario el primer sábado de cinco meses consecutivos.

Es importante señalar que estas condiciones se deben cumplir con la *intención de reparar el Inmaculado Corazón de María*. En cuanto a confesarse, se puede hacer durante los ocho días anteriores o posteriores al primer sábado de cada mes, siempre que se reciba la Sagrada Comunión en estado de gracia. Incluso la confesión mensual de uno todavía sería suficiente, siempre que uno recuerde formar la intención de hacer reparación al Inmaculado Corazón de María.

¿Por qué cinco sábados, se preguntarán algunos? Nuestro Señor Jesucristo mismo respondería a esta pregunta cuando, durante su aparición a Sor Lucía el 29 de mayo de 1930, explicó que esto es para hacer apariciones por cinco tipos de blasfemias y ofensas contra el Inmaculado Corazón de María, a saber: Blasfemias contra su Inmaculada Concepción , contra su virginidad perpetua, contra la maternidad divina y espiritual de María, blasfemias que implican el rechazo y deshonra de sus imágenes, y el descuido de inculcar en los corazones de los niños el conocimiento y el amor de esta Madre Inmaculada.

A los que cumplen con devoción la devoción de los Cinco Primeros Sábados, Nuestra Señora les ha prometido indefectiblemente asistirlos con todas las gracias necesarias para la salvación de sus almas en la hora de la muerte. Nuestra Señora también nos implora que ofrezcamos esta devoción por la salvación de los pecadores y por la paz en el mundo.

Somos una Parroquia de la Sagrada Familia, unida en el gozo del Espíritu Santo y en la caridad, como discípulos misioneros, jamén!

The Bereavement Committee is in need of volunteers. The Bereavement Committee reaches out to families who have suffered the loss of a loved one through death.


Committee members help with the reception, usually held in the parish auditorium, that often follows a funeral Mass or service.
