Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

This past weekend thousands of youths from parishes all over the archdiocese gathered downtown in Houston for the annual **Archdiocesan Youth Conference (AYC).** About twelve young men and women from our parish were among those who gathered, together with our Youth Minister, a few volunteers and myself. It was truly a holy gathering, infused with the presence of the Holy Spirit.

The theme for this year's **AYC** gathering was: **Everlasting Mercy**. It was taken from the Blessed Virgin Mary's Magnificat, when she had gone to visit her cousin Elizabeth: "The Mighty One has done great things for me, and holy is his name. His mercy is from age to age to those who fear him" (**Luke 1:49-50**). Indeed, the beauty of God's everlasting mercy was celebrated throughout the conference and all those in attendance were encouraged to receive God's mercy (especially through daily prayer, regular participation at Mass and the Sacrament of Reconciliation) and to become its conveyors to those we encounter daily.

This brings me to the feast we celebrate this weekend – the Feast of the Transfiguration of the Lord! On the mountain, Peter, James and John were privileged to witness Christ in His glory, and to hear the voice of the Heavenly Father in testimony to His Son. As God's only Begotten Son, Christ is "the image of the invisible God" (cf. Colossians 1:15), the refulgence of [God's] glory, the very imprint of his being" (see: **Hebrews 1:3**). That is to say, Christ, in his very being, makes God manifest! He manifests to us God's love and mercy, which have no limits. And as his followers, we are called to share his merciful love with all those we encounter.

Consider serving as a volunteer for our Faith Formation program. What an amazing way to be a conveyor of God's loving mercy to others! Saint Paul, in today's Second Reading, encourages this when he noted that "we [all] possess the prophetic message that is altogether reliable". This is the message of God's saving mercy and we are meant to share it as a light shining in а dark place, until day dawns and the morning star rises in your hearts". Whether it is with the young ones, the youth or adults who are seeking to become Catholic, there is a place for everyone who might be interested to volunteer in our parish Faith Formation. Come, join us in serving as conveyors of God's mercy through instructing others in the faith! God bless you as you do so!

We are one Holy Family Parish, united in the joy of the Holy Spirit and in charity, as missionary disciples, amen!

Mensaje del Pastor

Amadísimos en Cristo:

El fin de semana pasado, miles de jóvenes de parroquias de toda la arquidiócesis se reunieron en el centro de Houston para la **Conferencia Anual de la Juventud Arquidiocesana (AYC).** Unos doce hombres y mujeres jóvenes de nuestra parroquia se encontraban entre los que se reunieron, junto con nuestro Ministro de la Juventud, algunos voluntarios y yo. Fue verdaderamente una reunión santa, infundida con la presencia del Espíritu Santo.

El tema de la reunión de **AYC** de este año fue: Misericordia Eterna. Fue tomado del Magnificat de la Santísima Virgen María, cuando había ido a visitar a su prima Isabel: "Grandes cosas ha hecho por mí el Poderoso, y santo es su nombre. Su misericordia es de edad en edad para los que le temen" (Lucas 1:49-**50**). De hecho, la belleza de la eterna misericordia de Dios se celebró durante toda la conferencia y se animó a todos los asistentes a recibir la misericordia de Dios (especialmente a través de la oración diaria, la participación regular en la Misa y el Sacramento de la Reconciliación) y a convertirse en sus aquellos con los transmisores a que nos encontramos a diario.

Esto me lleva a la fiesta que celebramos este fin de semana: ¡la Fiesta de la Transfiguración del Señor! En la montaña, Pedro, Santiago y Juan tuvieron el privilegio de presenciar a Cristo en Su gloria y escuchar la voz del Padre Celestial en testimonio de Su Hijo. Como Hijo unigénito de Dios, Cristo es "la imagen del Dios invisible" (cf. **Colosenses 1:15**), el resplandor de la gloria [de Dios], la huella misma de su ser" (ver: Hebreos 1:3). Es decir, ¡Cristo, en su mismo ser, manifiesta a Dios! Él nos manifiesta el amor y la misericordia de Dios, que no tienen límites. Y como sus seguidores, llamados estamos а compartir su amor misericordioso con todos los que encontramos.

Considere servir como voluntario para nuestro programa de Formación de Fe. jQué asombrosa manera de ser un transmisor de la amorosa misericordia de Dios para los demás! San Pablo, en la segunda lectura de hoy, alienta esto cuando señaló que "[todos] poseemos el mensaje profético que es del todo confiable". Este es el mensaje de la misericordia salvadora de Dios y estamos destinados a compartirlo como una luz que brilla en un lugar oscuro, hasta que amanezca y el lucero de la mañana se levante en vuestros corazones". Ya sea con los jóvenes, los jóvenes o los adultos que buscan convertirse en católicos, hay un lugar para todos los que puedan estar interesados en ser voluntarios en nuestra formación de fe parroquial. ¡Ven, únete a nosotros para servir como transmisores de la misericordia de Dios al instruir a otros en la fe! ¡Dios te bendiga mientras lo haces!

The Bereavement Committee is in need of volunteers. The Bereavement Committee reaches out to families who have suffered the loss of a loved one through death.


Committee members help with the reception, usually held in the parish auditorium, that often follows a funeral Mass or service.


