Dearly Beloved in Christ:

Are you aware that we have a **Homebound Ministry** in our parish? The members of this ministry make regular visits to elderly and/or sickly parishioners who are homebound and are incapable of coming to Church. Also, the homebound ministers bring the love and comfort of our Lord Jesus Christ to those they visit by bringing them Holy Communion, sharing with them their companionship, and keeping them connected with the parish by bringing them the weekly parish bulletin. Occasionally, where there is need for the administration of the Sacraments of Confession and/or Anointing of the Sick, the ministers inform the priests who in turn, visit with them, providing them with these sacraments.

We have an active roster of homebound parishioners but we know there are others that we have yet to connect with. And we need your help to reach them as well. If you have family members, friends or neighbors who would benefit from this ministry, please call the parish to give us their contact information – name, address and a contact person for them, where applicable. You may also send this information via email to the Coordinator of our parish homebound ministry, Ms. Mary Ramirez at: carmelite1942@gmail.com.

In this post COVID Pandemic era, it is good to see so many of you at Mass! We know that a few of our parishioners are still hesitant to come back to church for various reasons that may border on health concerns. Let us continue to uphold one another in prayer even as we strive to practice safe hygiene. There may also be those who have just not made it a priority to come back to church, following the lockdown. We would like to encourage you to invite them to come with you to church. It is amazing how far a loving invitation will go! St. Peter was invited by his brother Andrew to come and see Jesus, the Messiah (see: John 1:40-43). Peter heeded his brother's invitation and his life was never the same after that!

Whether it is through connecting our homebound parishioners with our parish homebound ministry or inviting a friend and/or a *lapsed* parishioner, we want you to help us connect our brothers and sisters to Christ. The Bereavement Committee is in need of volunteers. The Bereavement Committee reaches out to families who have suffered the loss of a loved one through death.


Committee members help with the reception, usually held in the parish auditorium, that often follows a funeral Mass or service.

Sometimes in life, we all experience a sense of emptiness. This is normal. St. Augustine reminds us that we are made for God and that our hearts are restless until they rest in God! The Catholic Church, throughout the ages, continues to help people from all walks of life to encounter God who gives us true peace, happiness, forgiveness, joy, and the fulfillment we all desire. Why the Catholic Church?

The Catholic Church is a community of believers who love each other and come together to learn more about their Creator and become lifelong disciples. We learn from God through his teachings in the Holy Scripture, and model our lives to that of Christ our redeemer. New members are welcome to also learn and shape their lives to the Christain way of life.

As Catholics, we grow daily in our love for God who first loved us and continues to knock at the door of our hearts, so that he can come live in us and we in him. One thing about the journey of faith is that it begins with personal conviction and conversion. 
