#### Dearly Beloved in Christ:

There is an episode in the Bible where people were bringing children to Jesus that he might lay his hands on them and bless them but his disciples tried to stop them from doing so. When Jesus saw this, he rebuked them and said, "Let the children come to me, and do not prevent them!" (see: **Matthew 19:13-15**). Let the children come to Christ indeed. As parents, we desire to give the best to our children. When we bring our children to God (especially through the sacraments), teaching them the importance of having a healthy relationship with him right from when they are young, we are giving them the best!

At our **Holy Family School**, our goal is to support parents in this endeavor by helping to form our children into *saints and scholars*. We strive to do this by instilling a Godly centered academic, spiritual and well-rounded discipline to every child that walks through our doors. In today's Second Reading, we are reminded of the value of such a discipline: "My son, do not disdain the discipline of the Lord or lose heart when reproved by him; for whom the Lord loves, he disciplines". Thus, as we provide instructions centered on helping our children to excel academically, we also teach them how to be disciples of the Lord, that is, *how* to be *disciplined* in the ways of the Lord!

We have a very strong record on the island as Catholic education has always been a part of the educational system in Galveston since the early 1870s. And we want to keep that streak alive. To do so, we will need the cooperation of all parishioners. We all have a role to play. First, we would like to request for prayers. We know that it is only by God's grace that we can achieve any good work. Kindly pray for God's blessings upon our school community staff, children and their parents. In addition, consider enrolling your children in our school, where they will receive the blessings of a Catholic education. Also, our doors are always open and we would like for you to come and visit us sometimes. To all the parishioners who came out last Saturday to help 'freshen' up our school we say: thank you! and may God bless you abundantly, amen! There is a myriad of ways to help support our school. ### THE SACRAMENTS OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION FOR ADULTS

Sometimes in life, we all experience a sense of emptiness. This is normal. St. Augustine reminds us that we are made for God and that our hearts are restless until they rest in God! The Catholic Church, throughout the ages, continues to help people from all walks of life to encounter God who gives us true peace, happiness, forgiveness, joy, and the fulfillment we all desire.

Why the Catholic Church?

The Catholic Church is a community of believers who love each other and come together to learn more about their Creator and become lifelong disciples. We learn from God through his teachings in the Holy Scripture, and model our lives to that of Christ our redeemer. New members are welcome to also learn and shape their lives to the Christain way of life.

As Catholics, we grow daily in our love for God who first loved us and continues to knock at the door of our hearts, so that he can come live in us and we in him. One thing about the journey of faith is that it begins with personal conviction and conversion. Most of us have received the sacraments of Chirstian Initiation (Baptism, Holy Eucharist, and Confirmation); as we know, life does not begin and end with the sacraments, rather it is all about what we make of the inward grace that God freely bestows on us after we have received the sacraments.
