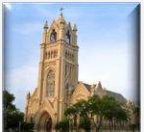

Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

The last weekend of each month has been designated as our **Capital Campaign weekend**, when we share updates about our ongoing campaign efforts to raise funds for our new **Parish Life Center**. We are grateful to all parishioners who continue to support this effort through their generous sharing of their time, talent and treasure. Today, we have raised over 3 million dollars in pledges and about 1.9 million dollars of that amount has been redeemed. As we gratefully celebrate this milestone, we recognize that there is still more to be done and we are appealing to every parishioner to graciously support our campaign endeavors.

Of the 2,080 registered parishioners/individuals in our parish, only about 450 have given and/or made pledges to the campaign. This means that we have the great potential to accomplish so much more! While we all have different giving abilities, we can all make equal sacrificial gifts. Someone once shared a remarkable story with me about a family who committed to sacrifice cable TV for a year so as to give to their parish campaign! In this day and age, we all know what a great sacrifice that was on their part!

We are not asking you to give up your TV subscription, of course, but we hope that you would consider making a sacrificial contribution to the campaign. Perhaps you could sacrifice the cost of a cup of coffee each month (approximately \$10) to give to the campaign for the length of the campaign period (i.e., 4 years). Perhaps you could give more than that (or less) each month, according to your circumstances; no matter the amount, it would go a long way to make a huge difference. In this week's bulletin, we have included a simple breakdown of how a monthly gift of \$2, for instance, given by a 100 families/individuals, could add up to make a great impact in a 4-year span. Our capital campaign is about building for the future and keeping the legacy of our Catholic faith alive and vibrant on the island and peninsula. We, ourselves, are the beneficiaries of the great sacrifices that were made by our fathers and mothers in the faith who helped build these beautiful places of worship. The baton is now in our hands; it is our turn to leave a mark by helping to build a gathering space for social, pastoral and spiritual events – the proposed **Parish Life Center**. I have made my own sacrificial contribution and humbly invite you to do so as well. May God, who loves a cheerful giver, bless us all as we work toward the realization of our campaign goals. Amen!

El último fin de semana de cada mes ha sido designado como nuestro **fin de semana de Campaña Capital**, cuando compartimos actualizaciones sobre nuestros esfuerzos de campaña en curso para recaudar fondos para nuestro nuevo **Centro de Vida Parroquial**. Estamos agradecidos con todos los feligreses que continúan apoyando este esfuerzo compartiendo generosamente su tiempo, talento y tesoro. Hoy, hemos recaudado más de 3 millones de dólares en promesas y se han redimido alrededor de 1.9 millones de dólares de esa cantidad. Mientras celebramos con gratitud este hito, reconocemos que aún queda más por hacer y hacemos un llamado a todos los feligreses para que apoyen amablemente los esfuerzos de nuestra campaña.

De los 2,080 feligreses/individuos registrados en nuestra parroquia, solo unos 450 han donado y/o hecho promesas para la campaña. ¡Esto significa que tenemos un gran potencial para lograr mucho más! Si bien todos tenemos diferentes habilidades para dar, todos podemos hacer los mismos obsequios de sacrificio. ¡Alguien una vez compartió una historia notable conmigo sobre una familia que se comprometió a sacrificar la televisión por cable durante un año para contribuir a la campaña de su parroquia! ¡En este día y época, todos sabemos el gran sacrificio que fue de su parte!

You might have wondered: could I do this? Did you have some singing experience in grade school or high school, college? (Clearly, you need to be able to "carry a tune".)

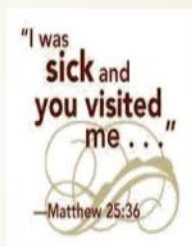

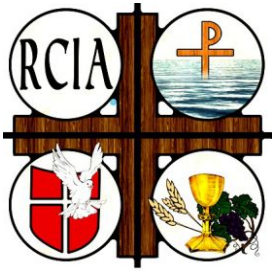
If you are interested, or would like more information, please contact the Parish office or drop by the Faith Formation Office. Monday - Friday 8:30 am- 4:30pm.

THE SACRAMENTS OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION FOR ADULTS

Sometimes in life, we all experience a sense of emptiness. This is normal. St. Augustine reminds us that we are made for God and that our hearts are restless until they rest in God! The Catholic Church, throughout the ages, continues to help people from all walks of life to encounter God who gives us true peace, happiness, forgiveness, joy, and the fulfillment we all desire.

Why the Catholic Church?

The Catholic Church is a community of believers who love each other and come together to learn more about their Creator and become lifelong disciples. We learn from God through his teachings in the Holy Scripture, and model our lives to that of Christ our redeemer. New members are welcome to also learn and shape their lives to the Christian way of life.

As Catholics, we grow daily in our love for God who first loved us and continues to knock at the door of our hearts, so that he can come live in us and we in him. One thing about the journey of faith is that it begins with personal conviction and conversion. Most of us have received the sacraments of Christian Initiation (Baptism, Holy Eucharist, and Confirmation); as we know, life does not begin and end with the sacraments, rather it is all about what we make of the inward grace that God freely bestows on us after we have received the sacraments. Yes, the administration of the sacraments may be within a day, but conversion is a lifelong process. The Holy Spirit of God is at work in us to help us discern and know what God's plans are for us as we continue on our journey through life.

So, if you are yet to receive the sacraments or if you are already baptized and have not yet received the sacrament of Confirmation and/or Holy Communion, please call the parish office. We will be glad to welcome you into our parish family. You will meet many nice and fun-loving people who are ready to help you understand more about the faith and to grow closer to God.

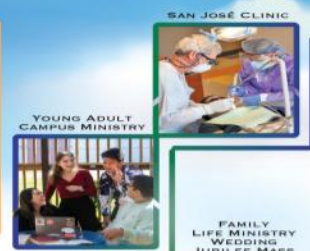
