Message from the Pastor

Dear Beloved in Christ:

This year marks the twenty-second anniversary of the September 11 terrorist attacks on our nation. According to an article by the New York Magazine, the total number of those killed in New York was 2,753. There were an additional 184 fatalities at the Pentagon and 40 in Pennsylvania. 9/11 is the deadliest terrorist attack in human history which, in addition to thousands of fatalities, also resulted in damage of property and infrastructure in excess of 10 billion dollars. It was an affront to the sacredness of human life everywhere.

I recall visiting New York in the summer of 2013 and making a stop at Ground Zero and the National September 11 Memorial. It was a moment of sad reflection and prayers, especially for the victims of the horrific attacks on 9/11. I left there with the distinct impression of the invincible power of goodness, for even amid the darkness of 9/11 there were many shining heroes. These were the brave public safety officers; the passengers of United Airlines Flight 93 who were willing to pay the ultimate price and fought their hijackers to prevent greater catastrophe; thousands of emergency rescue workers and volunteers; as well as the service animals that were part of the rescue operations.

9/11 pointed out the common enemy and seemingly gave justification to terminate them with extreme prejudice. As Christians however, we are called to love our enemies and pray for those who persecute us (See: **Matthew 5:44**). No doubt, 9/11 really makes this exhortation a very bitter pill to swallow. Yet, we must try. Our inspiration for doing so is Jesus Christ crucified. On the Cross, Jesus overcomes evil and violence, subduing them with Divine love. He offered forgiveness in the face of senseless violence – *Forgive them Father, for they do not know what they are doing!*

To forgive is not to condone evil. Rather, it is choosing not to perpetuate the lifespan of the hurt caused by the harm suffered. We can only achieve this by choosing to offer the evil suffered as well as the perpetrators to God, asking for his blessings (of conversion) on them and for his healing graces on us.

Of course, as a nation, we are obligated to work for the safety and protection of the citizenry as well as pursue justice for those who have been wronged; but we must do so not motivated by vengeance but the pursuit of justice, infused with genuine love. Saint Paul's exhortation in his Letter to the Romans is a fitting conclusion here: "Do not be conquered by evil but conquer evil with good" (**Romans 12:21**).

We are one **Holy Family Parish, united in the joy of the Holy Spirit and in charity, as missionary disciples, amen!**

Mensaje del Pastor

Amadísimos en Cristo:

Este año marca el vigésimo segundo aniversario de los ataques terroristas del 11 de septiembre en nuestra nación. Según un artículo de New York Magazine, el número total de muertos en Nueva York fue de 2.753. Hubo 184 muertes adicionales en el Pentágono y 40 en Pensilvania. El 11 de septiembre es el ataque terrorista más mortífero en la historia de la humanidad que, además de miles de muertes, también resultó en daños a la propiedad e infraestructura por más de 10 mil millones de dólares. Era una afrenta al carácter sagrado de la vida humana en todas partes.

Recuerdo haber visitado Nueva York en el verano de 2013 y haber hecho una parada en la Zona Cero y el Monumento Nacional del 11 de Septiembre. Fue un momento de triste reflexión y oración, especialmente por las víctimas de los terribles ataques del 11 de septiembre. Salí de allí con la clara impresión del poder invencible de la bondad, porque incluso en medio de la oscuridad del 11 de septiembre había muchos héroes brillantes. Estos fueron los valientes oficiales de seguridad pública; los pasajeros del vuelo 93 de United Airlines que estaban dispuestos a pagar el precio más alto y lucharon contra sus secuestradores para evitar una catástrofe mayor; miles de trabajadores y voluntarios de rescate de emergencia; así como los animales de servicio que formaron parte de las operaciones de rescate.

El 11 de septiembre señaló al enemigo común y aparentemente dio una justificación para acabar con ellos con un prejuicio extremo. Sin embargo, como cristianos, estamos llamados a amar a nuestros enemigos y orar por aquellos que nos persiguen (Ver: **Mateo 5:44**). Sin duda, el 11 de septiembre realmente hace que esta exhortación sea una píldora muy amarga de tragar. Sin embargo, debemos intentarlo. Nuestra inspiración para hacerlo es Jesucristo crucificado. En la Cruz, Jesús vence el mal y la violencia, sometiéndolos con el amor Divino. Ofreció el perdón ante la violencia sin sentido – *¡Perdónalos Padre, porque no saben lo que hacen!*

Perdonar no es condonar el mal. Más bien, es elegir no perpetuar la duración del daño causado por el daño sufrido. Solo podemos lograr esto eligiendo ofrecer a Dios el mal sufrido así como a los perpetradores, pidiendo sus bendiciones (de conversión) sobre ellos y sus gracias curativas sobre nosotros.

Por supuesto, como nación, estamos obligados a trabajar por la seguridad y protección de la ciudadanía, así como buscar justicia para aquellos que han sido agraviados; pero debemos hacerlo no motivados por la venganza sino por la búsqueda de la justicia, imbuidos de amor genuino. La exhortación de San Pablo en su Carta a los Romanos es aquí una conclusión adecuada: "No os dejéis vencer por el mal, sino vencid el mal con el bien" (**Romanos 12, 21**).

Somos una **Parroquia de la Sagrada Familia, unida en el gozo del Espíritu Santo y en la caridad, como discípulos misioneros, ¡amén!**

Sometimes in life, we all experience a sense of emptiness. This is normal. St. Augustine reminds us that we are made for God and that our hearts are restless until they rest in God! The Catholic Church, throughout the ages, continues to help people from all walks of life to encounter God who gives us true peace, happiness, forgiveness, joy, and the fulfillment we all desire.

Why the Catholic Church?

The Catholic Church is a community of believers who love each other and come together to learn more about their Creator and become lifelong disciples. We learn from God through his teachings in the Holy Scripture, and model our lives to that of Christ our redeemer. New members are welcome to also learn and shape their lives to the Christian way of life.

As Catholics, we grow daily in our love for God who first loved us and continues to knock at the door of our hearts, so that he can come live in us and we in him. One thing about the journey of faith is that it begins with personal conviction and conversion. Most of us have received the sacraments of Christian Initiation (Baptism, Holy Eucharist, and Confirmation); as we know, life does not begin and end with the sacraments, rather it is all about what we make of the inward grace that God freely bestows on us after we have received the sacraments.
