THE SACRAMENTS OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION FOR ADULTS

Sometimes in life, we all experience a sense of emptiness. This is normal. St. Augustine reminds us that we are made for God and that our hearts are restless until they rest in God! The Catholic Church, throughout the ages, continues to help people from all walks of life to encounter God who gives us true peace, happiness, forgiveness, joy, and the fulfillment we all desire.

Why the Catholic Church?

The Catholic Church is a community of believers who love each other and come together to learn more about their Creator and become lifelong disciples. We learn from God through his teachings in the Holy Scripture, and model our lives to that of Christ our redeemer. New members are welcome to also learn and shape their lives to the Christain way of life.

As Catholics, we grow daily in our love for God who first loved us and continues to knock at the door of our hearts, so that he can come live in us and we in him. One thing about the journey of faith is that it begins with personal conviction and conversion. 
