Dearly Beloved in Christ:

Chad Henry and I was born in Long Beach, CA on November 11, 1993 and moved to Sugar Land, TX in the summer of 1998 where I spent the rest of my childhood. I have an older brother, Spencer, who is a Captain in the U.S. Army and is stationed in South Carolina where he lives with his wife and their two sons. My younger brother, Wesley, is a seminarian for the Archdiocese of Galveston-Houston in his first year of Pre-Theology at St. Mary's Seminary in Houston. My parents, Dave and Sharon, reside in Richmond, TX and are both still working, although nearing retirement.



I am a cradle Catholic and upon moving to Texas we spent time at the parishes of St. Laurence and St. Theresa, both in Sugar Land, and Sacred Heart in Richmond. I grew up an avid athlete playing baseball and football through high school at Stephen F. Austin in Sugar Land. Upon graduating high school in the spring of 2012, I entered priestly formation for the Archdiocese of Galveston-Houston. I attended Holy Trinity Seminary in Irving, TX for priestly formation and received a Bachelor's Degree in Philosophy from the University of Dallas, which is a small catholic college right next to the seminary. After graduating from Holy Trinity and the University of Dallas in the spring of 2016 I attended St. Mary's Seminary in Houston for my theological studies from 2016-2021.

As many of you may remember, I did my pastoral year here at Holy Family during the 2018-2019 academic year and loved my time here on the island. After completing pastoral year and returning to my studies at St. Mary's, I was ordained to the Diaconate by the late Bishop George Sheltz on July 10, 2020. I served as a deacon at Resurrection Catholic Church in Denver Harbor which is about 3 miles east of Downtown Houston but much of my ministry was affected by COVID so I was not able to be as present at the parish as is usual for transitional deacons.

On Saturday, June 5, 2021 I was ordained to the Priesthood by Cardinal DiNardo at the Co-Cathedral of the Sacred Heart and the next day I celebrated my first Mass here at St. Mary's Cathedral Basilica on Corpus Christi Sunday. My first priestly assignment was as Parochial Vicar at St. Elizabeth Ann Seton from July 1, 2021 through October 2, 2022. I loved my time at St. Elizabeth; it was an amazing place to spend my first year as a priest and I am grateful for having been assigned there.

It is great to be back on the island! I loved my time here on pastoral year and am excited to be here as a priest. I am looking forward to the good things that lie ahead in Christ Jesus and Holy Family Parish. Ever since my pastoral year, Galveston has held a special place in my heart and it is good to be back.

#### THE SACRAMENTS OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION FOR ADULTS

Sometimes in life, we all experience a sense of emptiness. This is normal. St. Augustine reminds us that we are made for God and that our hearts are restless until they rest in God! The Catholic Church, throughout the ages, continues to help people from all walks of life to encounter God who gives us true peace, happiness, forgiveness, joy, and the fulfillment we all desire.

Why the Catholic Church?

The Catholic Church is a community of believers who love each other and come together to learn more about their Creator and become lifelong disciples. We learn from God through his teachings in the Holy Scripture, and model our lives to that of Christ our redeemer. New members are welcome to also learn and shape their lives to the Christain way of life.

As Catholics, we grow daily in our love for God who first loved us and continues to knock at the door of our hearts, so that he can come live in us and we in him. One thing about the journey of faith is that it begins with personal conviction and conversion. Most of us have received the sacraments of Chirstian Initiation (Baptism, Holy Eucharist, and Confirmation); as we know, life does not begin and end with the sacraments, rather it is all about what we make of the inward grace that God freely bestows on us after we have received the sacraments. Yes, the administration of the sacraments may be within a day, but conversion is a lifelong process. The Holy Spirit of God is at work in us to help us discern and know what God's plans are for us as we continue on our journey through life.




