Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

This week I would like to focus on our new parish ministry, which is aimed at providing loving support to parishioners whose spouses are deceased—the Holy Family Parish Widowed Network (HFPWN). For those who are keen observers, you would notice that we have replaced the word "Widow" with "Widowed" in the name of this group. The reason is because we want to emphasize that this ministry is intended for both widows and widowers.

On Sunday August 14th, we had the first Meet and Greet session for those who showed interest in the HFPWN ministry. I was truly glad to see many people show up, which was a testimony of the need for this ministry. The founding members have expressed enthusiasm and are eager about the potentials of this ministry to provide support to widowed parishioners.

This Sunday they will be having a potluck gathering in the rectory at St. Patrick's Church. Throughout the Gospels, we encounter Christ at table fellowship where all are welcome. It is our hope that through the HFPWN group, parishioners who mourn their loved ones will encounter the love of Christ and find the support and encouragement that they need.

A crucial part of the HFPWN is to do just that. Members are encouraged to send written notes to recently widowed parishioners, offering them the comfort of Christ. Thus, as the members mutually support each other, they in turn extend that love to others. This beautiful dynamic of fellowship and ministry is captured beautifully by Saint Paul when he said: "Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of compassion and God of all encouragement, who encourages us in our every affliction, so that we may be able to encourage those who are in any affliction with the encouragement with which we ourselves are encouraged by God" (2 Corinthians 1:3-4).

The HFPWN, like our parish Homebound Ministry, is one way we are striving to reduce the pain of isolation in our parish and the larger community as well. We are inviting all widows and widowers to be a part of this movement of love. Please come, and invite your friends and neighbors who may benefit from this association. All are welcome!

We are one Holy Family Parish, united in the joy of the Holy Spirit and in charity, as missionary disciples, amen!


