# Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

This weekend we join the universal Church in celebrating World Mission Sunday! The theme for this year's is: You shall be My Witnesses" (cf. Acts 1:8). The Church by her very nature is missionary. The Gospel of Matthew concludes with Christ's Great Command to his disciples to "Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, until the end of the age" (Matthew 28:19-20).

Pope Francis, reflecting on this year's theme for World Mission Sunday reminds all Christians that we are all called to bear witness to the Gospel of Christ and to rely on the grace and strength of the Holy Spirit to accomplish this. It is customary on this weekend to take up a special collection for the **Society of the Propagation of the Faith** in Rome, which helps provide crucial support in mission territories in Asia, Africa, the Pacific Islands, and parts of Latin America and Europe.

Specifically, the Holy Father designates the funds realized from this collection to help in the formation of seminarians and Religious men and women; to build schools, orphanages and churches in remote areas with limited resources; and to support priests and Religious men and women who work in missionary areas. Financial donations to support the missionary activities of the Church could be made using the regular collection envelopes or could be dropped off at the parish office; kindly include "World Mission Sunday" on the memo line for checks.

The work of evangelization, while it is supported by donations, is ultimately sustained by the power and grace of the Holy Spirit. Let us all endeavor to offer special prayers and sacrifices for the promotion of the missionary activities of the Church. Consider praying the Rosary with your loved ones, asking for the maternal intercessions of the Blessed Virgin Mary in support of the work of evangelization throughout the world.

I would like to end on a note of gratitude to all of you for your generous contributions to the annual **Diocesan Services Funds (DSF)**. Through your generosity, we were able to exceed our parish goal once again. Thank you for helping to promote the Gospel locally.
