Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

Fall is upon us and as the year draws to its close, let us take a moment to reflect on our lives. What are we grateful for this year? What lessons are enshrined in our hearts in light of our experiences this year? Fall ushers in a beautiful metamorphosis as trees shed their leaves gradually, revealing new and spectacular colors. What might God be inviting you to shed in your life so as to reveal the beauty He is bestowing upon you?

We are inviting everyone to our annual Parish **Advent Mission and Retreat**, which is scheduled for **November 28** through **30**. Our theme this year will be focused on the centrality of the **Holy Eucharist**, the gift of Christ Himself to us!

During our Advent Mission, we will reflect on the Scriptural foundations of the gift of the Holy Eucharist, explore its implications for us as disciples of Christ, examine in the light of faith some of the documented Eucharistic miracles in the life of the Church, as well as have the opportunity to adore Christ in the Holy Eucharist while we celebrate the mercy of God in the holy Sacrament of Confession. We encourage all parish groups to cancel their meetings the week of the Advent Mission and to encourage their members to attend the retreat instead.

The Advent Mission/Retreat will be a healthy way to reflect on the trajectory of our lives thus far; we hope you can take advantage of this opportunity for prayer and self-reflection. Perhaps another activity that could also assist us in this regard is our participation in the **Novena Prayer** for the holy souls in purgatory. Praying for the dead invites us to reflect on our own mortality and gain some wisdom in the process as well. As the Psalmist says, "Teach us to count our days aright [Lord], that we may gain wisdom of heart" (**Psalm 90:12**). You can find the Novena Prayer in this week's bulletin.

Fall also means that Thanksgiving and Christmas are around the corner! As we give thanks to God for all His blessings, especially the gift of our Savior Jesus Christ who became one like us to redeem us from the bondage of our sins, let us keep in mind our brothers and sisters in need. May our plans for these holidays include those who may dread these festive seasons because of their particular circumstances – the sick and the shut-ins, the homeless, those who feel isolated and/or are far from their loved ones, and our brothers and sisters in need.

We are one **Holy Family Parish, united in the joy of the Holy Spirit and in charity, as missionary disciples, amen!**
