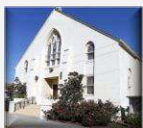

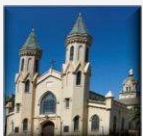

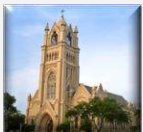

## Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

We celebrated **World Mission Sunday** three weekends ago (October 22/23). Pope Francis, emphasizing that we are all called to be faithful witnesses to Christ, urged us to rely constantly on the graces of the Holy Spirit to accomplish the works of evangelization. In order to continue its support of the missionary activities of the Church, each year our archdiocese participates in the **Missionary Cooperative Plan** by inviting a missionary to preach at a parish for mission appeals.

This weekend, we are pleased to welcome Rev. Fr. John Ugobueze to our parish. Fr. John is a priest of the archdiocese of Onitsha in eastern Nigeria. He is here for a mission appeal on behalf of his home diocese. The archdiocese of Onitsha was founded on April 18, 1950, though its roots go as far back as 1889 when the Apostolic Prefecture of Lower Niger was formed. The diocese has 191 parishes, 550 diocesan priests, 215 seminarians, and about 123 catholic schools.

The vibrancy of the church in the archdiocese of Onitsha is a reflection of the Church in Africa as a whole. Once a purely mission territory, the African Church is now, by the grace of the Holy Spirit, a huge contributor of missionaries to the world. Addressing the Pan-African Catholic Congress on Theology, Society and Pastoral Life, which was held at the Catholic University of East Africa, Nairobi Kenya, in July of this year, Pope Francis acknowledged that the African Church is “outgoing”. Her outgoing nature, of course, is made more readily manifest in her sons and daughters who now serve in regions outside the African continent.

It has been said that “some give to the mission by going; others go to the mission by giving”. Through our support of the missionary activities of the church – whether it is through our participation in the annual DSF campaign, World Mission Sunday, this weekend’s Mission Appeal, etc. – we serve as missionaries.

**And as we support the missions in foreign lands, let us remember that charity begins at home. We hope that you can join us this Sunday at our School’s Fall Festival. Your presence and support help the parish to continue her mission of forming future saints and scholars at our school.**

We are one **Holy Family Parish**, united in the joy of the Holy Spirit and in charity, as missionary disciples, amen!

## Mensaje del Pastor

Amadísimos en Cristo:

Celebramos el **Domingo Mundial de las Misiones** hace tres fines de semana (22/23 de octubre). El Papa Francisco, enfatizando que todos estamos llamados a ser testigos fieles de Cristo, nos instó a confiar constantemente en las gracias del Espíritu Santo para realizar las obras de evangelización. Para continuar apoyando las actividades misioneras de la Iglesia, cada año nuestra arquidiócesis participa en el Plan **Cooperativo Misionero** al invitar a un misionero a predicar en una parroquia para llamamientos misioneros.

Este fin de semana, nos complace dar la bienvenida al Rev. Fr. John Ugobueze a nuestra parroquia. Padre John es sacerdote de la arquidiócesis de Onitsha en el este de Nigeria. Está aquí para un llamamiento misionero en nombre de su diócesis de origen. La arquidiócesis de Onitsha fue fundada el 18 de abril de 1950, aunque sus raíces se remontan a 1889 cuando se formó la Prefectura Apostólica del Bajo Níger. La diócesis tiene 191 parroquias, 550 sacerdotes diocesanos, 215 seminaristas y alrededor de 123 escuelas católicas.

La vitalidad de la iglesia en la arquidiócesis de Onitsha es un reflejo de la Iglesia en África como un todo. Una vez que fue un territorio puramente de misión, la Iglesia Africana es ahora, por la gracia del Espíritu Santo, un gran contribuyente de misioneros al mundo. Al dirigirse al Congreso Católico Panafricano sobre Teología, Sociedad y Vida Pastoral, que se celebró en la Universidad Católica de África Oriental, Nairobi, Kenia, en julio de este año, el Papa Francisco reconoció que la Iglesia africana es “saliente”. Su naturaleza extrovertida, por supuesto, se manifiesta más fácilmente en sus hijos e hijas que ahora sirven en regiones fuera del continente africano.

Se ha dicho que “algunos dan a la misión yendo; otros van a la misión dando”. A través de nuestro apoyo a las actividades misioneras de la iglesia, ya sea a través de nuestra participación en la campaña anual DSF, el Domingo Mundial de las Misiones, la Campaña Misionera de este fin de semana, etc., servimos como misioneros. **Y mientras apoyamos las misiones en tierras extranjeras, recordemos que la caridad comienza en casa. Esperamos que pueda acompañarnos este domingo en el Festival de Otoño de nuestra Escuela. Su presencia y apoyo ayudan a la parroquia a continuar su misión de formar futuros santos y eruditos en nuestra escuela.**

Somos una **Parroquia de la Sagrada Familia**, unida en el gozo del Espíritu Santo y en la caridad, como discípulos misioneros, ¡amén!

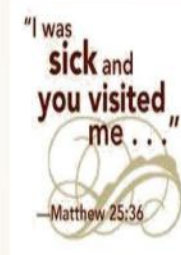

## **WHO IS LIKE YOU LORD?**

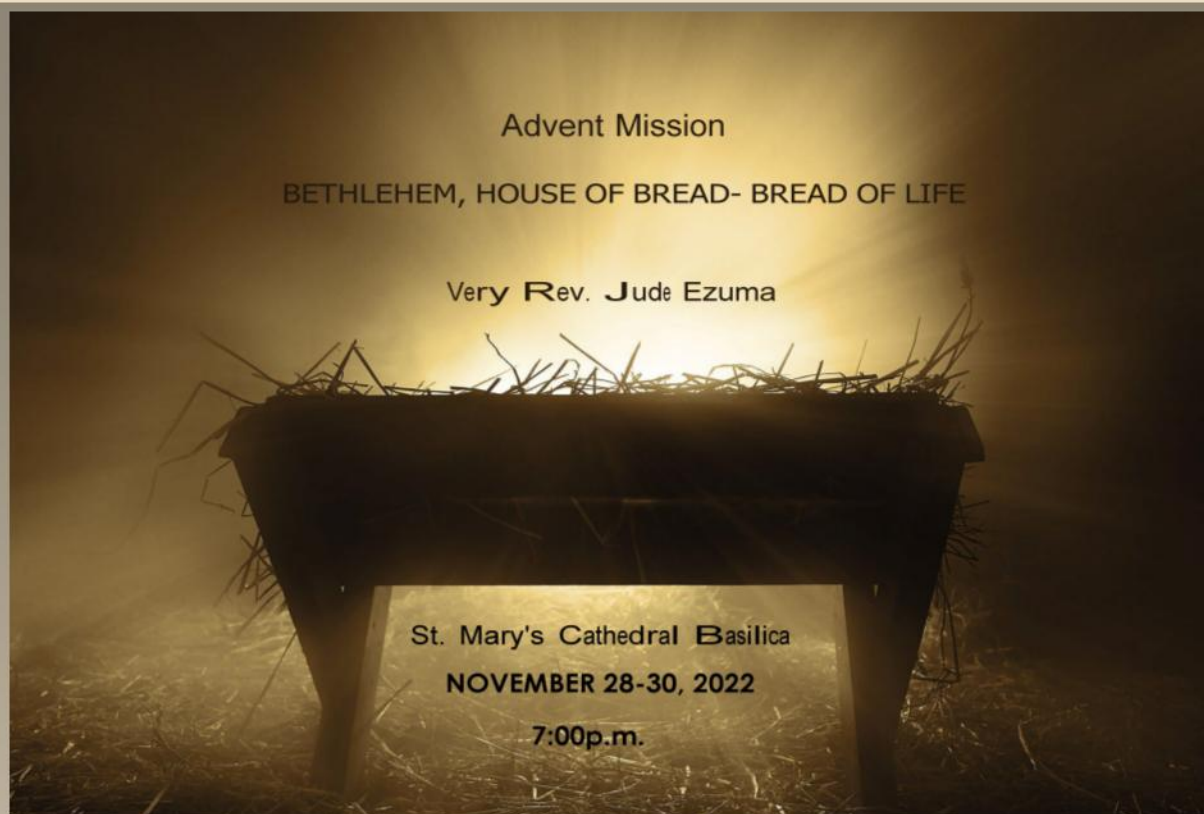



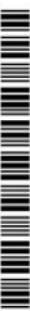
