Message from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved in Christ:

This week, we shift our focus to the Blessed Virgin Mary as we celebrate the Feasts of the Immaculate Conception (on December 8th) and Our Lady of Guadalupe (December 12th). Mary is addressed as *Theotokos*, which means "God-bearer". She is the Mother of the Savior, Jesus Christ, prepared by a singular grace of God to be the Mother of God. It is this grace, bestowed upon her by God that we celebrate when we recall the Feast of the Immaculate Conception.

Full of grace, Mary has also become a powerful and reliable bearer of grace for all her children. As *Theotokos*, she continues to "facilitate" our encounter with her Son, Jesus the Savior. The veritable witnesses of the numerous Marian Apparitions throughout human history testify to this. Our Lady of Guadalupe comes to an indigenous people, bringing the message of salvation to them.

As a loving mother, she guides us, giving us assurance of her maternal succor. Her words to the visionary of Guadalupe, Saint Juan Diego, atop mount Tepeyac in 1531, should be a source of encouragement for us all: "Am I not here, I, who am your Mother? Are you not under my shadow and protection? Am I not the source of your joy? Are you not in the hollow of my mantle, in the crossing of my arms? Do you need anything more? Let nothing else worry you, disturb you."

Every loving mother desires only the best for her children. Let us therefore be confident in approaching the Ever Blessed Virgin Mary, our Mother, to ask for her intercessions. Please join us to celebrate the Feasts of the Immaculate Conception and Our Lady of Guadalupe. See **page 13** for the Mass schedule for these feast days. In particular, we hope you can join us on Saturday, December 10th, for a grand celebration of the Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe. We will start the celebration with a Rosary Procession on Broadway, accompanied by songs and dancing by various dancing groups. Following the Mass we will have a reception in the Parish Life Center.

Oh Mary, Mother of God, refuge of sinners and help of Christians, pray for us who have recourse to thee, Amen!
